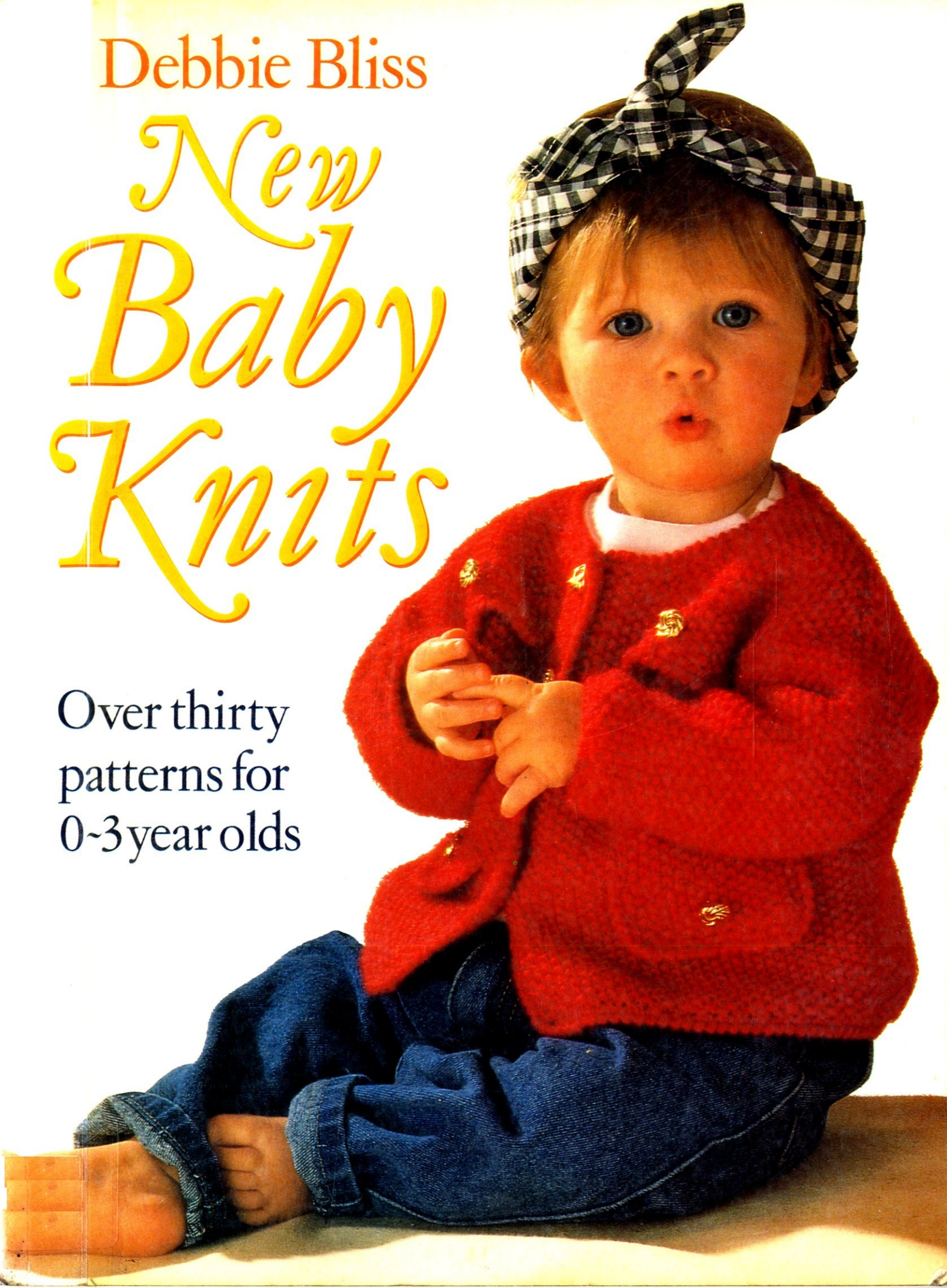

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Introduction

I am delighted to have been given the opportunity to present another collection of designs for 0–3 year-olds. As with my first book, *Baby Knits*, my aim has been to combine style with comfort and wearability, and the designs cover a range of knitting skills, with a combination of simple knits in basic stitches to more complicated patterns.

I have designed all the garments to have a fairly generous fit, but as actual measurements are included in the patterns, readers can select the size they prefer. All the yarns used are machine washable and where suitable I have quoted both pure wool and wool mix yarns.

The styles range from new-look Aran and delicate Fair Isles to tapestry effects and nursery motifs, and I have also included variations on some favourites from *Baby Knits*.

Basic Information

Yarns

All yarn amounts are based on average requirements and should therefore be regarded as approximate. Use only the yarn specified: we cannot be responsible for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.

Tension/stitch gauge

The flow of yarn which is controlled by the knitter is known as tension/stitch gauge, and is as personal as handwriting. Some knitters put more stress on the yarn, making a smaller stitch and tighter knitted fabric; others put less stress on the yarn and make a looser fabric. For this reason a tension sample is essential for the success of your finished garment.

You must always measure the tension/stitch gauge before you start to make anything. This is necessary for two reasons: to check your tension/stitch gauge against the measurements given in a pattern, and to calculate the number of stitches to cast on and rows to work when you are planning a design of your own. The tension/stitch gauge is always given at the beginning of a pattern and states the number of stitches and rows to the centimetre or inch using the yarn, needles and stitch pattern for a given design.

Calculating the number of stitches and rows is known as tension/stitch gauging. Three factors influence this:

- 1 The size of needles and type of yarn.
- 2 The type of stitch pattern.
- 3 The knitter.

Making a tension/stitch gauge sample

Use the same yarn, needles and stitch pattern as those to be used for the main work. Knit a sample at least 12.5 × 12.5 cm/5 × 5 in square. Smooth out the finished sample on a flat surface but do not stretch it.

Measuring the number of stitches

This determines the width of the knitting. Place a steel ruler or tape measure across the sample and mark 10 cm/4 in across with pins. Count the number of stitches between the pins. For complete accuracy, pin out the sample several times. An extra half stitch will prove to be vital when you are working from a knitting pattern or when

you are gauging the number of stitches to cast on for your own design.

Adjusting tension/stitch gauge

The tension/stitch gauge can be adjusted by changing the size of needles and working another sample. If there are too many stitches to the centimetre or to the inch, your tension/stitch gauge is too tight and you should change to needles a size larger. If there are too few stitches, your tension/stitch gauge is too loose and you should change to needles a size smaller. If the number of stitches is correct but the number of rows incorrect, check the length as you proceed with the pattern.

Measuring the number of rows

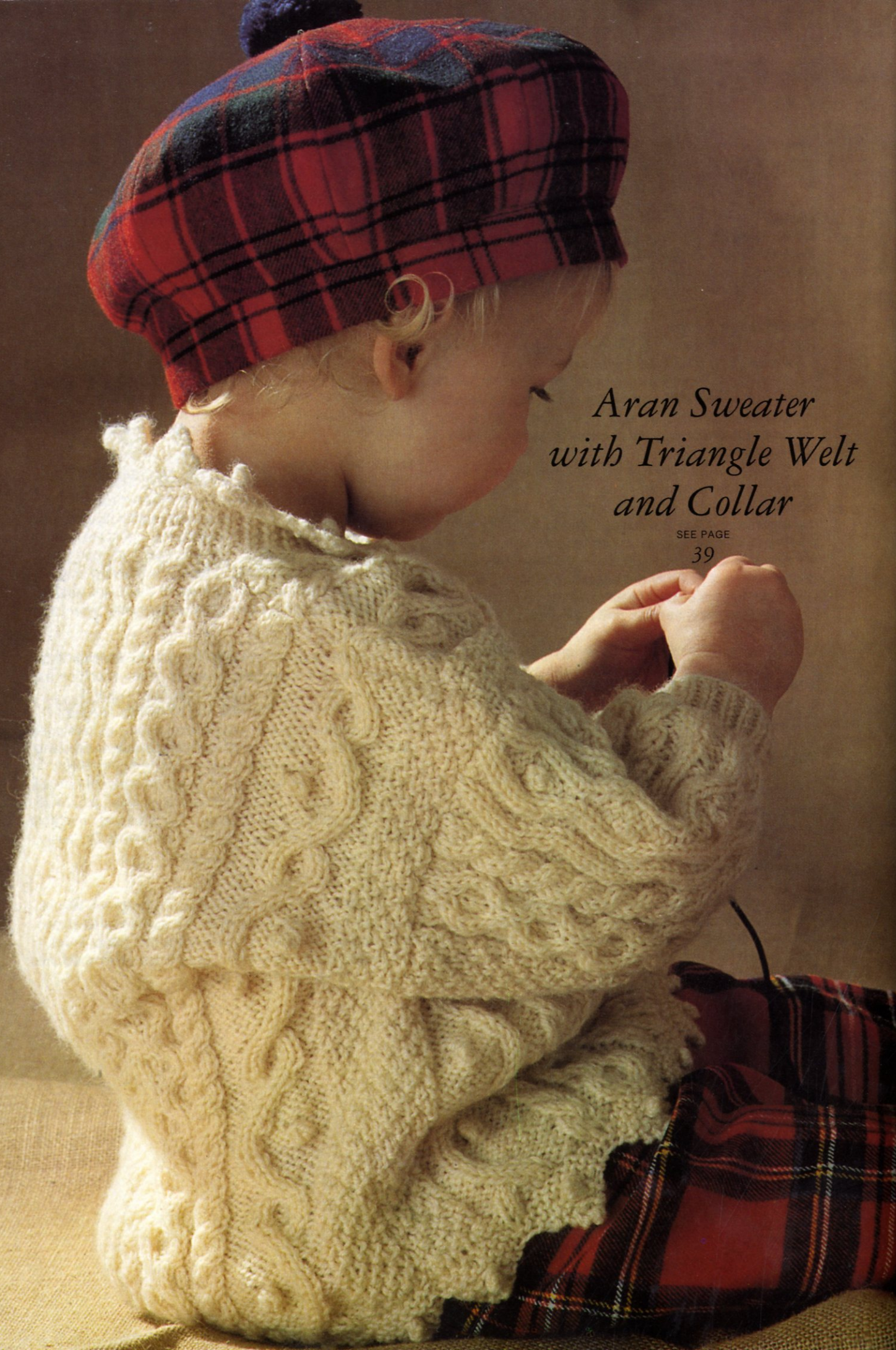
This determines the depth of the knitting. The tension/stitch gauge also determines the number of rows to the centimetre or to the inch. Place a ruler vertically along the fabric and mark out 10 cm/4 in with pins. Count the number of rows between the pins. From this count you can gauge the number of rows needed to reach the planned length of a design. You can also calculate where shaping is required and the position of increases and decreases.

Garment care

A knitted garment will have a much longer life and better appearance if it is properly cared for. Always look on the ball band and check instructions for cleaning and pressing. Where the garment should be handwashed, wash in lukewarm water using a soap especially designed for knitwear. Do not leave to soak, immerse garment and squeeze it gently, avoiding wringing or rubbing. Rinse thoroughly in tepid water, then gently squeeze to remove all excess water. Hold the garment at all times otherwise the weight will pull it out of shape. Place a towel on a table and dry the garment flat, patting it into shape. Dry away from direct heat.

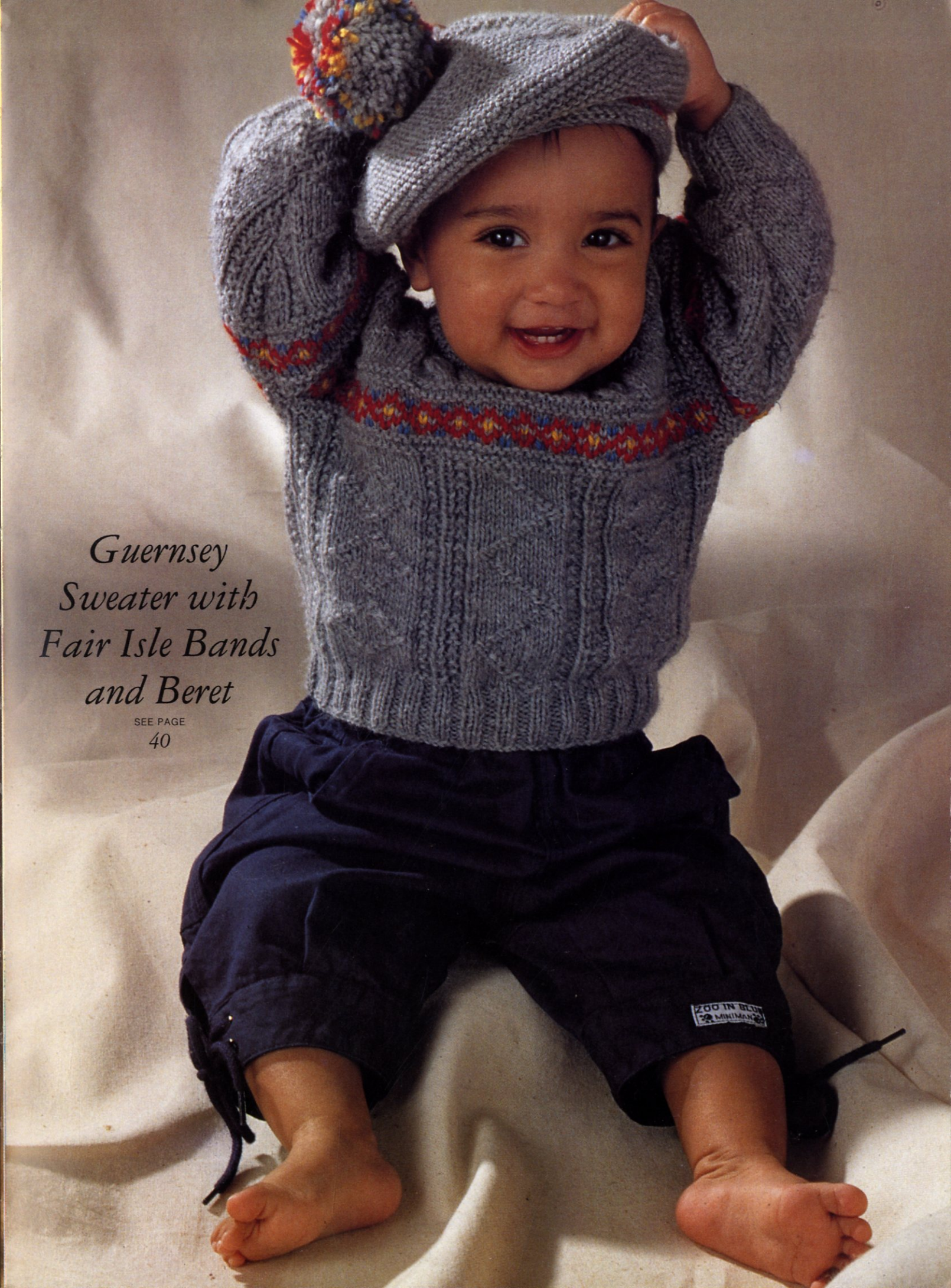

MATERIALS

8 (9) 50g balls of Hayfield Pure Wool Classics DK or 6 (7) 50g balls of Hayfield Gramplan DK.

1 pair each of 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) and 4 mm (No 8/US 5) knitting needles.
Cable needle.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit age 1–2 (2–3) years

All round at chest	68 (73) cm	26¾ (28¾) in
Length to shoulder	38 (43) cm	15 (17) in
Sleeve seam	20 (24) cm	8 (9½) in

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm/4 in over st st on 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

Cr 4L = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front, P2, then K2 from cable needle.
Cr 4R = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back, K2, then P2 from cable needle.

CF = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front, P1, then K2 from cable needle.

CB = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back, K2, then P1 from cable needle.

C4B = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

C4F = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at front, K2, then K2 from cable needle.

MK = (Make Knot) [K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1] all in next st, then with point of left-hand needle, pass 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th sts over 1st st.

Panel A – worked over 12 sts.

1st row (wrong side) K2, P2, K4, P2, K2.
2nd row P2, K2, P4, K2, P2.
3rd and every foll alt row K the K sts and P the P sts as they appear.
4th row P2, Cr 4L, Cr 4R, P2.
6th row P4, Cr 4L, P4.
8th row P6, CF, P3.
10th row P7, CF, P2.
12th row P3, MK, P4, K2, P2.
14th row P7, CB, P2.
16th row P6, CB, P3.
18th row P4, C4B, P4.
20th row P2, Cr 4R, Cr 4L, P2.
22nd row As 2nd row.
24th row As 4th row.
26th row P4, Cr 4R, P4.
28th row P3, CB, P6.
30th row P2, CB, P7.
32nd row P2, K2, P4, MK, P3.

34th row P2, CF, P7.

36th row P3, CF, P6.

38th row P4, C4F, P4.

40th row As 20th row.

These 40 rows form patt.

Panel B – worked over 10 sts.

1st row (wrong side) K1, P8, K1.
2nd row P1, K8, P1.
3rd and 2 foll alt rows As 1st row.
4th row P1, C4B, C4F, P1.
6th row As 2nd row.
8th row P1, C4F, C4B, P1.
These 8 rows form patt.

Panel C – worked over 20 sts.

1st row (wrong side) [K3, P2] twice, [P2, K3] twice.
2nd row [P2, CB] twice, [CF, P2] twice.
3rd row and every foll alt row K the K sts and P the P sts as they appear.
4th row P1, [CB, P2] twice, CF, P2, CF, P1.
6th row [CB, P2] twice, pick up loop between sts and [K1, P1, K1] into it, turn, P3, turn, slip 1, K2 tog, pssso, P1, then pass the bobble st over this st, P1, CF, P2, CF.
8th row [CF, P2] twice, [P2, CB] twice.
10th row P1, [CF, P2] twice, CB, P2, CB, P1.
12th row [P2, CF] twice, [CB, P2] twice.
These 12 rows form patt.

Panel D – worked over 12 sts.

1st row (wrong side) K2, P2, K4, P2, K2.
2nd row P2, K2, P4, K2, P2.
3rd row and every foll alt row K the K sts and P the P sts as they appear.
4th row P2, Cr 4L, Cr 4R, P2.
6th row P4, Cr 4R, P4.
8th row P3, CB, P6.
10th row P2, CB, P7.
12th row P2, K2, P4, MK, P3.
14th row P2, CF, P7.
16th row P3, CF, P6.
18th row P4, C4F, P4.
20th row P2, Cr 4R, Cr 4L, P2.
22nd row As 2nd row.
24th row As 4th row.
26th row P4, Cr 4L, P4.
28th row P6, CF, P3.
30th row P7, CF, P2.
32nd row P3, MK, P4, K2, P2.
34th row P7, CB, P2.
36th row P6, CB, P3.
38th row P4, C4B, P4.
40th row As 20th row.
These 40 rows form patt.

Back

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 102 (110) sts.
Work in patt as follows:
1st row (wrong side) K1, [P1, K1] 3(5) times, work 1st row of Panel A, *K1, P4, K1, work 1st row of Panel B, K1, P4, K1*, work 1st row of Panel C, rep from * to * once,

work 1st row of Panel D, K1, [P1, K1] 3 (5) times.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] 3 (5) times, work 2nd row of Panel D, *P1, K4, P1, work 2nd row of Panel B, P1, K4, P1*, work 2nd row of Panel C, rep from * to * once, work 2nd row of Panel A, P1, [K1, P1] 3 (5) times.

3rd row P1, [K1, P1] 3 (5) times, work 3rd row of Panel A, *K1, P4, K1, work 3rd row of Panel B, K1, P4, K1*, work 3rd row of Panel C, rep from * to * once, work 3rd row of Panel D, P1, [K1, P1] 3 (5) times.

4th row K1, [P1, K1] 3 (5) times, work 4th row of Panel D, P1, C4B, P1, work 4th row of Panel B, P1, C4B, P1, work 4th row of Panel C, P1, C4F, P1, work 4th row of Panel B, P1, C4F, P1, work 4th row of Panel A, K1, [P1, K1] 3 (5) times.

These 4 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels until work measures 35 (40) cm/13¾ (15¼) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 16 (17) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 16 (18) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 38 (40) sts on a holder.

Front

Work as given for Back until work measures 29 (34) cm/11½ (13½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row Patt 39 (42), turn.
Work on this set of sts only.
Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 32 (35) sts rem.
Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.
Shape shoulder
Cast off 16 (17) sts at beg of next row. Patt 1 row. Cast off rem 16 (18) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 24 (26) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to end. Complete to match first side.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, cast on 40 (44) sts. Work in K1, P1 rib for 3 cm/1¼ in.

Next row Rib 0 (2), [inc in each of next 3 sts, rib 1] to last 0 (2) sts, rib 0 (2). 70 (74) sts. Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Work in patt as follows:

1st row (wrong side) K1, [P1, K1] 4 (5) times, work 1st row of Panel B, K1, P4, K1, work 1st row of Panel C, K1, P4, K1, work 1st row of Panel B, K1, [P1, K1] 4 (5) times.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] 4 (5) times, work 2nd row of Panel B, P1, K4, P1, work 2nd row of Panel C, P1, K4, P1, work 2nd row of Panel B, P1, [K1, P1] 4 (5) times.

3rd row P1, [K1, P1] 4 (5) times, work 3rd row of Panel B, K1, P4, K1, work 3rd row of Panel C, K1, P4, K1, work 3rd row of Panel B, P1, [K1, P1] 4 (5) times.

4th row K1, [P1, K1] 4 (5) times, work 4th

row of Panel B, P1, C4B, P1, work 4th row of Panel C, P1, C4F, P1, work 4th row of Panel B, K1, [P1, K1] 4 (5) times.

These 4 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of next and 2 foll 2nd (3rd) rows, then on every foll 3rd row until there are 94 (102) sts, working inc sts into double moss st (side edge) patt. Cont without shaping until work measures 20 (24) cm/8 (9½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Collar

Join right shoulder seam. With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, pick up and K 23 sts down left front neck, K across 24 (26) sts at centre front, dec 4 (2) sts evenly, pick up and K 23 sts up right front neck and K across 38 (40) sts on back neck, dec 6 (2) sts evenly. 98 (108) sts. Work 7 rows in K1, P1 rib, inc one st at centre of last row on 1st size only. 99 (108) sts. K 3 rows.

***Next row** (right side) K9, turn. Work on

these sts only.

Next row K2 tog tbl, K5, K2 tog.

Next row K3, MK, K3.

Next row K2 tog tbl, K3, K2 tog.

Next row K5.

Next row K2 tog tbl, K1, K2 tog.

Next row K3.

Next row Sl 1, K2 tog, psso. Fasten off.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts.

Rep from * until all sts are worked off.

Welt Edgings

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, pick up and K 81 (90) sts evenly along cast on edge of Back. K 3 rows. Now work as given for collar from * until all sts are worked off.

Work front edging in same way.

To Make Up

Join left shoulder seam and rib section of collar.

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams.

Join side and sleeve seams.

MATERIALS

Sweater: 3 (4) × 50g balls of Hayfield Grampian DK in main colour (M).

Small amounts of same in 3 colours (A, B and C).

1 pair each of 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) and 4 mm (No 8/US 5) knitting needles. Cable needle. 3 buttons.

Beret: 1 × 50g ball of Hayfield Grampian DK in main colour (M).

Small amount of same in 3 colours (A, B and C).

1 pair of 3¾ mm (No 9/US 4) knitting needles.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit age 6 (12) months

All round at chest

57 (64) cm 22½ (25) in

Length to shoulder

28 (33) cm 11 (13) in

Sleeve seam 16 (22) cm 6¼ (8½) in

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm/4 in over st st on 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

See page 39.

NOTE

Strand yarn not in use loosely across wrong side to keep fabric elastic when working Fair Isle.

Panel A – worked over 13 sts.

1st row (right side) K13.

2nd row P13.

3rd row K6, P1, K6.

4th row P5, K3, P5.

5th row K4, P2, K1, P2, K4.

6th row P3 [K2, P3] twice.

7th row K2, P2, K5, P2, K2.

8th row P1, K2, P7, K2, P1.

9th row As 7th row.

10th row As 6th row.

11th row As 5th row.

12th row As 4th row.

13th row As 3rd row.

14th row P13.

Rep 3rd to 14th rows for patt.

Panel B – worked over 11 sts.

1st row (right side) K1, P2, K8.

2nd row P7, K2, P2.

3rd row K3, P2, K6.

4th row P5, K2, P4.

5th row K5, P2, K4.

6th row P3, K2, P6.

7th row K7, P2, K2.

8th row P1, K2, P8.

9th row K8, P2, K1.

10th row P2, K2, P7.

11th row K6, P2, K3.

12th row P4, K2, P5.

13th row K4, P2, K5.

14th row P6, K2, P3.

15th row K2, P2, K7.

16th row P8, K2, P1.

These 16 rows form patt.

Panel C – worked over 11 sts.

1st row (right side) K11.

2nd row P11.

3rd to 10th rows Work 1st to 8th rows of Panel B.

These 10 rows form patt.

Panel D – worked over 8 sts.

1st row (right side) P2, K4, P2.

2nd row K2, P4, K2.

3rd row P2, slip next 2 sts onto cable

needle and leave at front, K2, then K2 from

cable needle, P2.

4th row As 2nd row.

5th and 6th rows As 1st and 2nd rows.

These 6 rows form patt.

Panel E – worked over 13 sts.

1st row (right side) K13.

2nd row P13.

3rd row K6, P1, K6.

4th row P5, K1, P1, K1, P5.

5th row K4, P1, [K1, P1] twice, K4.

6th row P3, K1, [P1, K1] 3 times, P3.

7th row K2, P1, [K1, P1] 4 times, K2.

8th row P1, [K1, P1] 6 times.

9th row As 7th row.

10th row As 6th row.

11th row As 5th row.

12th row As 4th row.

13th row As 3rd row.

14th row P13.

These 14 rows form patt.

Panel F – worked over 11 sts.

1st row (right side) K11.

2nd row P11.

3rd to 10th rows Work 9th to 16th rows of

Panel B.

These 10 rows form patt.

Sweater

Back

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 66 (74) sts.

1st row (right side) K2, [P2, K2] to end.

2nd row P2, [K2, P2] to end.

Rep last 2 rows until welt measures 3 cm/1¼ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row and inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 69 (77) sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles. Work in main patt as follows:

1st row (right side) K0 (2), P0 (3), K2 (1),* P3, K1, P3, work 1st row of Panel A, P3, K1, P3*, work 1st row of Panel B, rep from * to * once, K2 (1), P0 (3), K0 (2).

2nd row P0 (1), [P1, K1] 0 (2) times, P2 (1),* K1, [P1, K1] 3 times, work 2nd row of Panel A, K1, [P1, K1] 3 times*, work 2nd row of Panel B, rep from * to * once, P2 (1), [K1, P1] 0 (2) times, P0 (1).

These 2 rows set main patt. Cont in main patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels until work measures 16 (18) cm/6¼ (7) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. P 4 rows.

**Work Fair Isle border as follows:

1st row (right side) K1 B, [1M, 1A, 1M, 1B] to end.

2nd row P1 M, [1A, 1M] to end.

3rd row K1A, [1M, 1C, 1M, 1A] to end.

4th row As 2nd row.

5th row As 1st row.

Cont in M only, P 5 rows**.

Work in yoke patt as follows:

1st row (right side) K1, [K1, P3] 2 (3) times, work 1st row of Panels C, D, E, D and F, [P3, K1] 2 (3) times, K1.

2nd row P1, [P1, K1] 4 (6) times, work 2nd row of Panels F, D, E, D and C, [K1, P1] 4 (6) times, P1.

These 2 rows set yoke patt. Cont in yoke patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels until work measures 28 (33) cm/11 (13) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 20 (23) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Leave rem 29 (31) sts on a holder.

Front

Work as given for Back until work measures 24 (28) cm/9½ (11) in from beg, ending

with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row Patt 28 (31), turn.

Work on this set of sts only. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at neck edge on every row until 20 (23) sts rem.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge. Cast off. With right side facing, slip centre 13 (15) sts onto a holder, join yarn to rem sts and patt to end. Complete to match first side.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 38 (42) sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 3 cm/1¼ in, ending with a wrong side row and inc 13 (9) sts evenly across last row. 51 sts. Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Work in main patt as follows:

1st row (right side) Work 1st row of Panel A, P3, K1, P3, work 1st row of Panel B, P3, K1, P3, work 1st row of Panel A.

2nd row Work 2nd row of Panel A, K1, [P1, K1] 3 times, work 2nd row of Panel B, K1, [P1, K1] 3 times, work 2nd row of Panel A. These 2 rows set main patt. Cont in main

patt, *at the same time* inc one st at each end of next and every foll 2nd (4th) row until there are 69 sts, working inc sts to

match side edge patt on Back.

Cont without shaping until work measures 12 (18) cm/4¾ (7) in, ending with a wrong side row. P 4 rows. Now work as given for Back from ** to **. Cast off.

Neckband

Join right shoulder seam.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 18 sts down left front neck, K across 13 (15) sts at centre front, pick up and K 18 sts up right front neck, K across 29 (31) sts on back neck. 78 (82) sts. Beg with a 2nd row, work 8 rows in rib as given for Back. Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 30 (34) sts evenly across left front shoulder and neckband.

Beg with a 2nd row, work 3 rows in rib as

given for Back.

1st buttonhole row Rib 4(5), [cast off 2, rib 7 (8) sts more] twice, cast off 2, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib to end, casting on 2 sts over those cast off in previous row. Rib 3 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

Work to match buttonhole band, but picking up sts across left back shoulder and neckband and omitting buttonholes.

To Make Up

Lap buttonhole band over button band and catch down at side. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of right sleeve to shoulder seam and centre of left sleeve in line with buttonholes.

Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Beret

With 3¾ mm (No 9/US 4) needles and M, cast on 75 sts. K 5 rows.

Inc row K4, [M1, K1, M1, K10] 6 times, M1, K1, M1, K4, 89 sts.

Now work 1st to 5th rows of Fair Isle border as given for Back of Sweater.

P 1 row in M.

Cont in M only and garter st (every row K), work as follows:

Inc row K5, [M1, K1, M1, K12] 6 times, M1, K1, M1, K5, K 5 rows.

Inc row K6, [M1, K1, M1, K14] 6 times, M1, K1, M1, K6, K 5 rows.

Cont in this way inc 14 sts on next and every foll 6th row until there are 159 sts. K 4 rows.

Dec row K8, [K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K18] 6 times, K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K8, K 4 rows.

Dec row K7, [K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K16] 6 times, K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K7, K 4 rows.

Dec row K6, [K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K14] 6 times, K2 tog, K1, K2 tog, K6.

Cont in this way, dec 14 sts on every 5th row until 33 sts rem. K 1 row.

Next 2 rows K1, [K2 tog] to end. 9 sts. Break off yarn, thread end through rem sts, pull up, secure, then join seam.

Using all four colours, make a large pompon and attach to top of beret.

When working in patt, strand yarn not in use loosely across wrong side to keep fabric elastic.

Back

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and M, cast on 73 (79:85) sts.

1st row (right side) K1, [P1, K1] to end.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

Rep these 2 rows until work measures 4 cm/1½ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row and inc 6 sts evenly across last row. 79 (85:91) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, work patt from chart as indicated for Back, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right until work measures 18 (21:23) cm/7 (8¼:9) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 9 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 61 (67:73) sts.

Keeping patt correct, cont without shaping until work measures 29 (33:36) cm/11½ (13:14) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 8 (9:10) sts at beg of next 4 rows. Cast off rem 29 (31:33) sts.

Left Front

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and M, cast on 67 (73:79) sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 4 cm/1½ in, ending with a wrong side row and inc 6 sts evenly across last row. 73 (79:85) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, work patt from chart as indicated for Left Front for 4 (6:6) rows.

Shape front

Keeping patt correct, dec one st at end (front edge) of next row and at beg of foll row, then work 1 row straight. Cont dec one st at front edge on next 2 rows, then work 1 row straight until 49 (59:69) sts rem, ending with a dec row. Now dec one st at front edge on every foll alt row until work measures 18 (21:23) cm/7 (8¼:9) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armhole

Cont to dec at front edge as before, cast off 9 sts at beg of next row.

Keeping armhole edge straight, cont to dec at front edge as before until 16 (18:20) sts rem.

Cont without shaping, until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 8 (9:10) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 8 (9:10) sts.

Right Front

Work as given for Left Front, following chart as indicated for Right Front and reversing all shaping.

Sleeves

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and M,

cast on 39 (41:41) sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 4 cm/1½ in, ending with a wrong side row and inc 4 (8:14) sts evenly across last row. 43 (49:55) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, work in patt from chart as indicated for Back, at the same time, inc one st at each end of every foll 4th (5th:6th) row until there are 61 (67:73) sts, working inc sts into patt.

Cont without shaping until work measures 22 (25:29) cm/8¾ (10:11½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 10 rows. Cast off rem 11 (17:23) sts.

Front Band

With 3 mm (No 11/US 2) needles and M, cast on 7 sts. Work in garter st (every row K)

until band, when slightly stretched, fits up along front edge of Right Front, across back neck and down front edge of Left Front. Cast off.

Ties (make 2)

With 3 mm (No 11/US 2) needles and M, cast on 7 sts.

Work in garter st until work measures 25 (28:31) cm/10 (11:12) in.

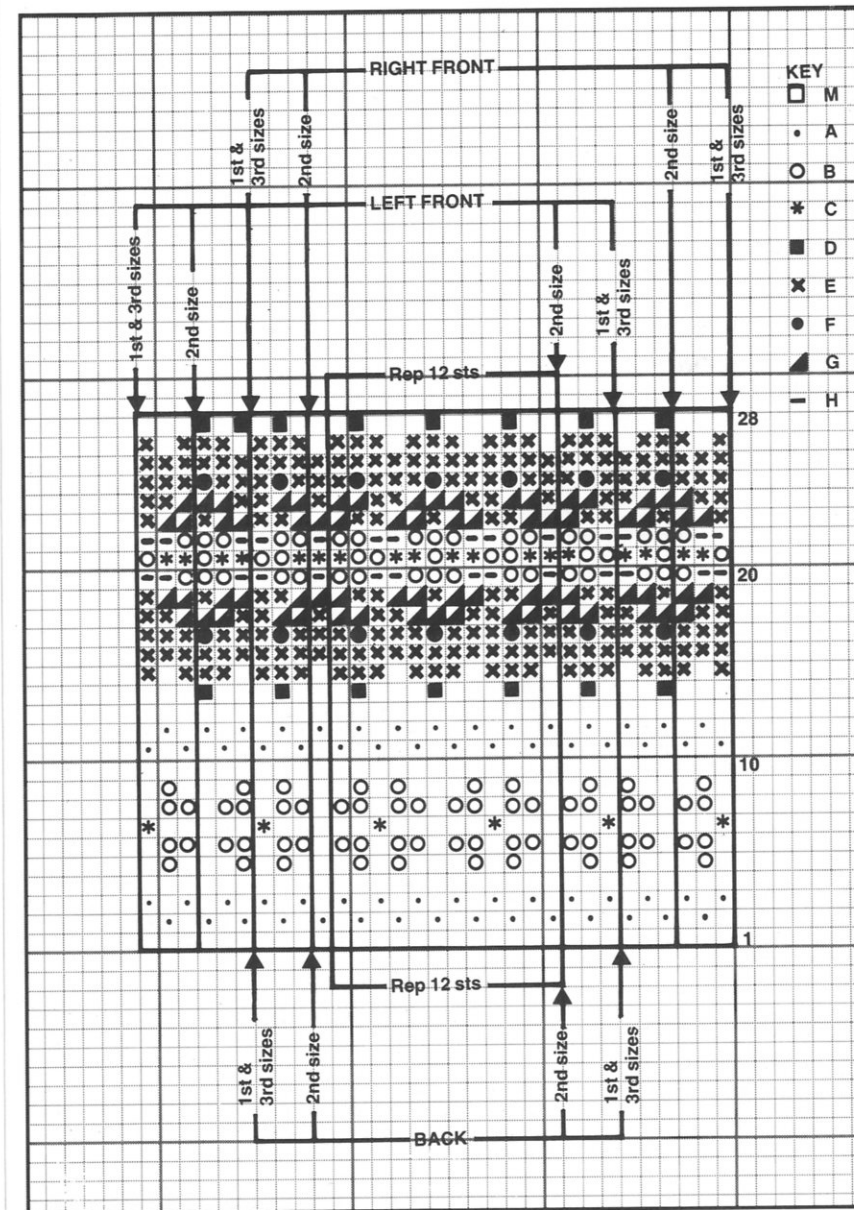

Jacket

Back

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 67 (73:77) sts. K 4 rows, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Change to M and cont in garter st until work measures 16 (20:24) cm/6¼ (8:9½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 (5:5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 59 (63:67) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 27 (33:38) cm/10½ (13:15) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 8 (9:9) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 8 (9:9) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 27 (29:31) sts on a holder.

Pocket Linings (Make 2)

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and M, cast on 15 (17:17) sts. K 20 (22:22) rows. Leave these sts on a spare needle.

Left Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 31 (35:37) sts. K 4 rows, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Change to M. K 20 (22:22) rows.

Place pocket

Next row K9 (10:11), slip next 15 (17:17) sts

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 16 (17:18) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 8 (8:9) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 8 (9:9) sts.

Right Front

Work as given for Left Front, reversing all shaping and placing pocket as follows:

Next row K7 (8:9), slip next 15 (17:17) sts onto a holder, K across 15 (17:17) sts of one pocket lining, K to end.

Sleeves

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 34 (40:44) sts. K 4 rows, thus ending with a wrong side row.

Change to M and cont in garter st, inc one st at each end of every 6th (7th:8th) row until there are 54 (62:66) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 18 (23:26) cm/7 (9:10¼) in, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Pocket Tops

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and A, K across sts of one pocket top inc one st at centre. 16 (18:18) sts. K 4 rows. Cast off knitwise.

Right Front Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and A, pick up and K 43 (52:63) sts evenly along front edge of Right Front, picking up and P sts from wrong side over last 5 cm/2 in. K 4 rows. Cast off knitwise.

Left Front Band

Work to match Right Front Band, picking up and P sts from wrong side over first 5 cm/2 in.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and A, pick up and K 21 (23:23) sts up right front neck, picking up and P sts from wrong side over first 3 cm/1¼ in, K across 27 (29:31) sts at back neck, pick up and K 21 (23:23) sts down left front neck, picking up and P sts from wrong side over last 3 cm/1¼ in. 69 (75:77) sts. K 4 rows. Cast off knitwise.

To Make Up

With B and C embroider flowers and leaves in lazy daisy st with French Knot (see diagram page 61) in centre on pockets and at centre of lower edge of sleeves as shown.

Catch down pocket linings and sides of pocket tops. Sew in sleeves, gathering slightly at top and sewing last 2 cm/1¼ in of row ends of sleeve tops to cast off sts at armholes.

Join side and sleeve seams. Turn top corners of fronts over for lapels and sew buttons to each through both thicknesses.

Shoes

With 3 mm (No 11/US 2) needles and A, cast on 13 sts for top.

K 20 rows, thus ending with a wrong side row. Leave these sts.

With 3 mm (No 11/US 2) needles and A, cast on 17 sts, then with right side facing pick up and K14 sts along right row end edge of top, K13 sts across, then pick up and K14 sts along other side of top, turn and cast on 17 sts. 75 sts.

Shape sole

1st row Slip 1, K32, K2 tog, K5, K2 tog, K to end.

2nd row Slip 1, K31, K2 tog, K5, K2 tog, K to end.

3rd row Slip 1, K2, K2 tog, K24, K2 tog, K3, K3 tog, K3, K2 tog, K24, K2 tog, K3.

4th and 5th rows Slip 1, K to end.

6th row K2 tog, [K3, K2 tog, K22, K2 tog] twice, K3, K2 tog.

7th and 8th rows Slip 1, K to end.

9th row K2 tog, K2, K2 tog, K18, [K2 tog, K1] 4 times, K17, K2 tog, K2, K2 tog.

10th row Slip 1, K to end.

11th row Slip 1, [K2 tog, K1] 3 times, K10, [K2 tog, K1] 4 times, K10, [K2 tog, K1] 3 times. 41 sts. Cast off.

With 3 mm (No 11/US 2) needles and A, cast on 45 sts for strap. K 2 rows.

Buttonhole row K3, yf, K2 tog, K to end. K 1 row. Cast off knitwise.

Join back and sole seam. Place centre of strap to back seam of shoe and sew 1.5 cm/½ in in each side of seam. Sew on button. With B and C, embroider flower in lazy daisy stitch with French Knot (see diagram page 75) in centre on top of shoe as shown.

Make another shoe in same way, reversing buttonhole row.

Back

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and A, cast on 75 (79:83) sts.

1st row (right side) K1, [P1, K1] to end.
2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.
Rep these 2 rows until work measures 3 cm/1¼ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Beg with a K row and working in st st and stripe patt of 2 rows B, 2 rows A throughout, cont until work measures 13 (15:17) cm/5 (6:6¾) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 67 (71:75) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 24 (27:30) cm/9½ (10½:11¼) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 9 (9:10) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 9 (10:10) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Cast off rem 31 (33:35) sts.

Front

Work as given for Back until work measures 13 (15:17) cm/5 (6:6¾) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armholes and divide for front opening
Next row Cast off 4, K until there are 31 (33:35) sts on right hand needle, cast off next 5 sts, K to end.

Work on last set of 35 (37:39) sts only. Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row. 31 (33:35) sts. Cont without shaping until work measures 19 (22:25) cm/7½ (8¾:10) in from beg, ending at inside edge.

Shape neck

Cast off 4 (4:5) sts at beg of next row and 2 (3:3) sts at beg of foll alt row. Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows, then on 2 foll alt rows. 18 (19:20) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at armhole edge.

Shape shoulder

Work in rib as given for Back for 3 cm/1¼ in, ending with a right side row.

Next row Rib 5 (5:4), [M1, rib 2, M1, rib 1] to last 5 (4:4) sts, M1, rib to end. 56 (60:64) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Work in st st and stripe patt as given for Back, at the same time, inc one st at each end of every 9th row until there are 62 (68:74) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 16 (18:20) cm/6¼ (7:8) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Collar

Join shoulder seams. With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, B and right side facing, pick up and K22 (22:24) sts up right front neck, 33 (33:36) sts across back neck and 22 (22:24) sts down left front neck. 77 (77:84) sts. K 3 rows.

Next row Rib 1 (1:2), M1, [rib 2, M1, rib 3, M1] to last 1 (1:2) sts, rib to end. 108 (108:117) sts.
K 12 rows.

***1st row** (right side) K9, turn. Work on these 9 sts only.

2nd row K2 tog tbl, K5, K2 tog.

3rd row K7.

4th row K2 tog tbl, K3, K2 tog.

5th row K5.

6th row K2 tog tbl, K1, K2 tog.

7th row K3.

8th row Slip 1, K2 tog, pssso and fasten off. With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts. Rep from * until all sts are worked off.

Button Band

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, B and right side facing, pick up and K 18 (18:20) sts evenly along left side edge of front opening, omitting collar. K 12 rows. Cast off.

Buttonhole Band

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, B and right side facing, pick up and K 18 (18:20) sts evenly along right side edge of front opening, omitting collar. K 5 rows, dec one st at each end of last row on 3rd size only.

****1st row** K9, turn. Work on these 9 sts only.

2nd row (buttonhole) K2 tog tbl, K2, yf, K2 tog, K1, K2 tog.
Now work 3rd to 8th rows of collar.** With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts. Rep from ** to ** once more.

To Make Up

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Bootees

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 40 sts. K 1 row.

Cont in st st and stripe patt of 2 rows B, 2 rows A throughout, work as follows:

Next row Inc in first st, P18, inc in each of next 2 sts, P18, inc in last st. Work 1 row.

Next row Inc in first st, P20, inc in each of next 2 sts, P20, inc in last st. Work 1 row.

Next row Inc in first st, P22, inc in each of next 2 sts, P22, inc in last st. 52 sts. Work 6 rows.

Shape instep

Next row K30, slip 1, K1, pssso, turn.

Next row P9, P2 tog, turn.

Next row K9, slip 1, K1, pssso, turn.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more, then the 1st of the 2 rows again.

Next row K to end. 40 sts. Work 2 rows across all sts.

Shape back heel

Next row P8, turn. Work 7 rows on these 8 sts. Leave these sts on a spare needle.

With wrong side facing, slip next 24 sts onto a holder, join yarn to rem 8 sts and work 8 rows.

Next row P to end then P across 8 sts of other side of back heel. 16 sts.

Cont in A only.

Next row Cast on 22 sts, P to end.

Buttonhole row K to last 3 sts, yf, K2 tog, K1. P 1 row. Cast off.

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, A and right side facing, pick up and K 8 sts down inside edge of back heel, K across 24 sts on a holder, pick up and K 8 sts up inside edge of back heel. 40 sts. Cast off knitwise. With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and B, cast on 45 sts for edging. K 4 rows.

Now rep from * as given for Collar of Sweater until all sts are worked off. Join back heel and sole seam. Sew on edging to strap. Sew on button.

Make another bootie, reversing strap.

Next row Rib 4 (5:7:4), [inc in next st, rib 7 (6:5:5) sts] to last 5 (5:8:5) sts, inc in next st, rib to end. 91 (99:107:115) sts.

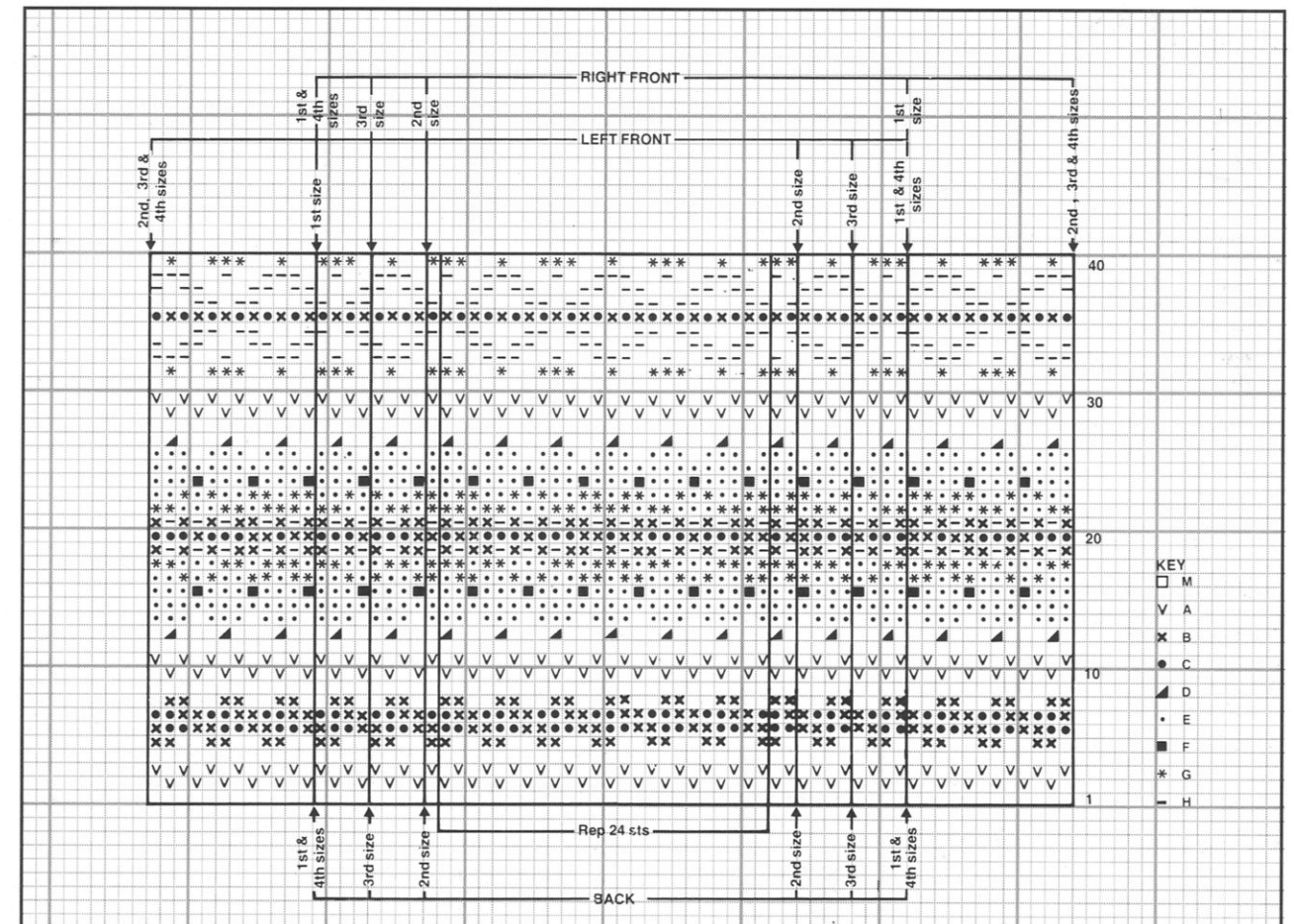

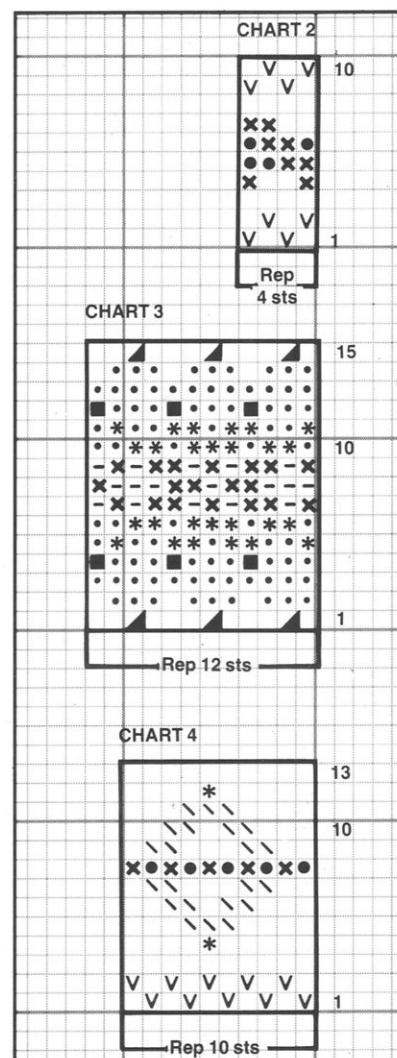

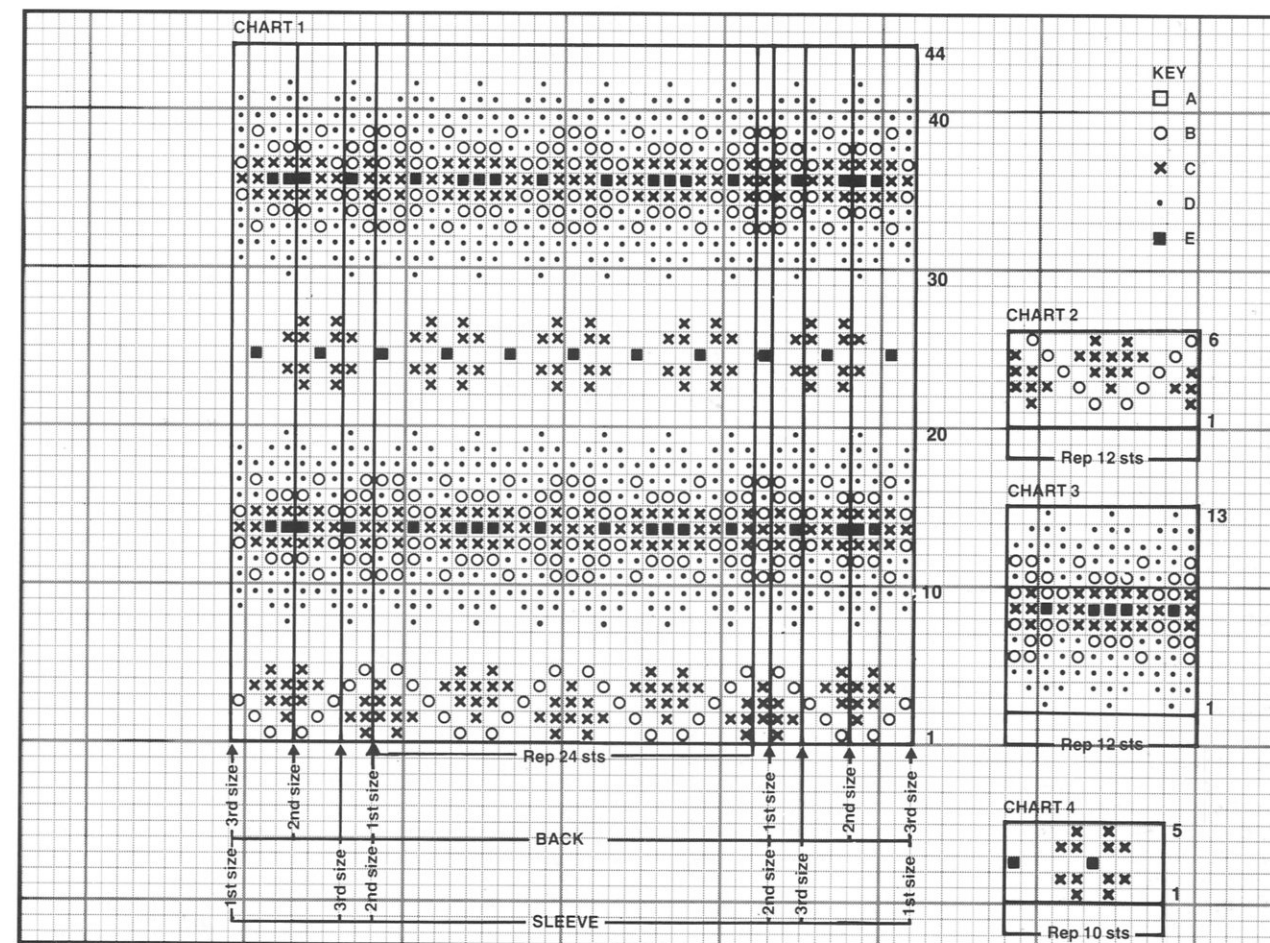

Work as given for Back until work measures 24 (27:31) cm/9½ (10½:12) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row Patt 29 (33:36), turn.

Work on this set of sts only. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at neck edge on every row until 22 (26:28) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 11 (13:14) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 11 (13:14) sts.

With right side facing, slip centre 15 (17:19) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to end. Complete to match first side.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 33 (37:41) sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 5 cm/2 in, ending with a wrong side row and inc 10 (12:12) sts evenly across last row. 43 (49:53) sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart 1 as

indicated for Sleeve, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of every 2nd (3rd:3rd) row until there are 71 (75:79) sts, working inc sts into patt.

Cont without shaping until work measures 22 (25:28) cm/8¾ (10:11) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Collar

Join shoulder seams.

With set of four 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, A and right side facing, slip first 8 (9:10) sts from holder at centre front onto a safety pin, join yarn to next st and K rem 7 (8:9) sts, pick up and K 16 sts up right front neck, K across 29 (31:35) sts on back neck, pick up and K 16 sts down left front neck then K sts from safety pin. 76 (80:86) sts. Work in rounds of K1, P1 rib for 2 cm/¾ in, dec one st at end of last round.

Turn and cont backwards and forwards as follows:
Next round Rib 3, work 3 times in next st, rib to last 4 sts, work 3 times in next st, rib 3. Rib 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows until collar measures 8 (8:9) cm/3 (3:3½) in from beg. Cast off loosely.

To Make Up

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams.

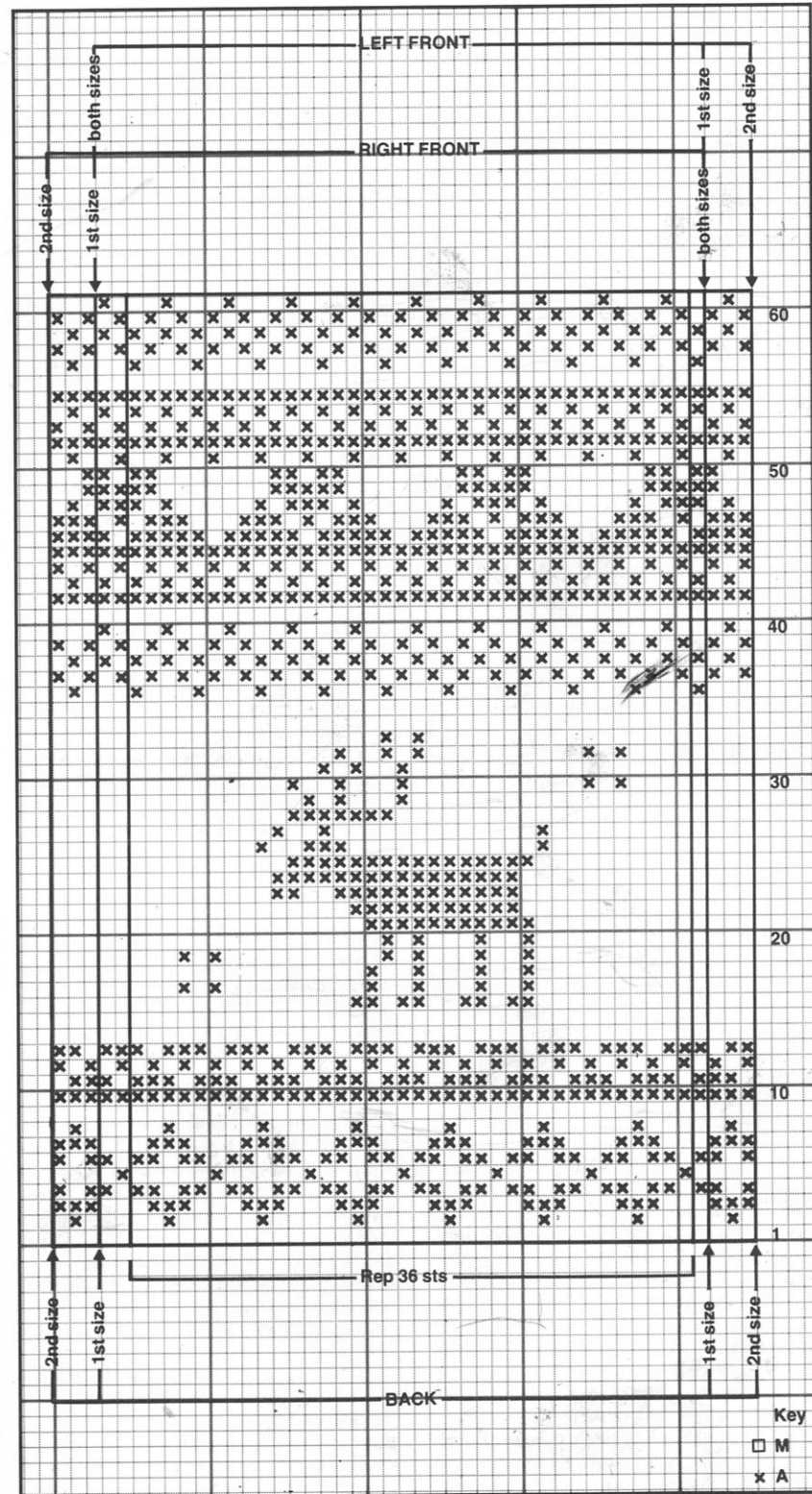

Cont without shaping until work measures 18 (22) cm/7 (8¾) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 26 sts up right front neck, K across 33 (35) sts on back neck, pick up and K 26 sts down left front neck. 85 (87) sts.

Beg with a 2nd row, work in rib as given for Back for 3 cm/1¼ in. Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 61 (73) sts along Right Front to top of neckband. Beg with a 2nd row, work 3 rows in rib as given for Back.

Work across all sts until collar fits up shaped edge of Left Front to centre back neck. Complete other half of collar to match first half, but working decreases instead of increases.

Welt Edging

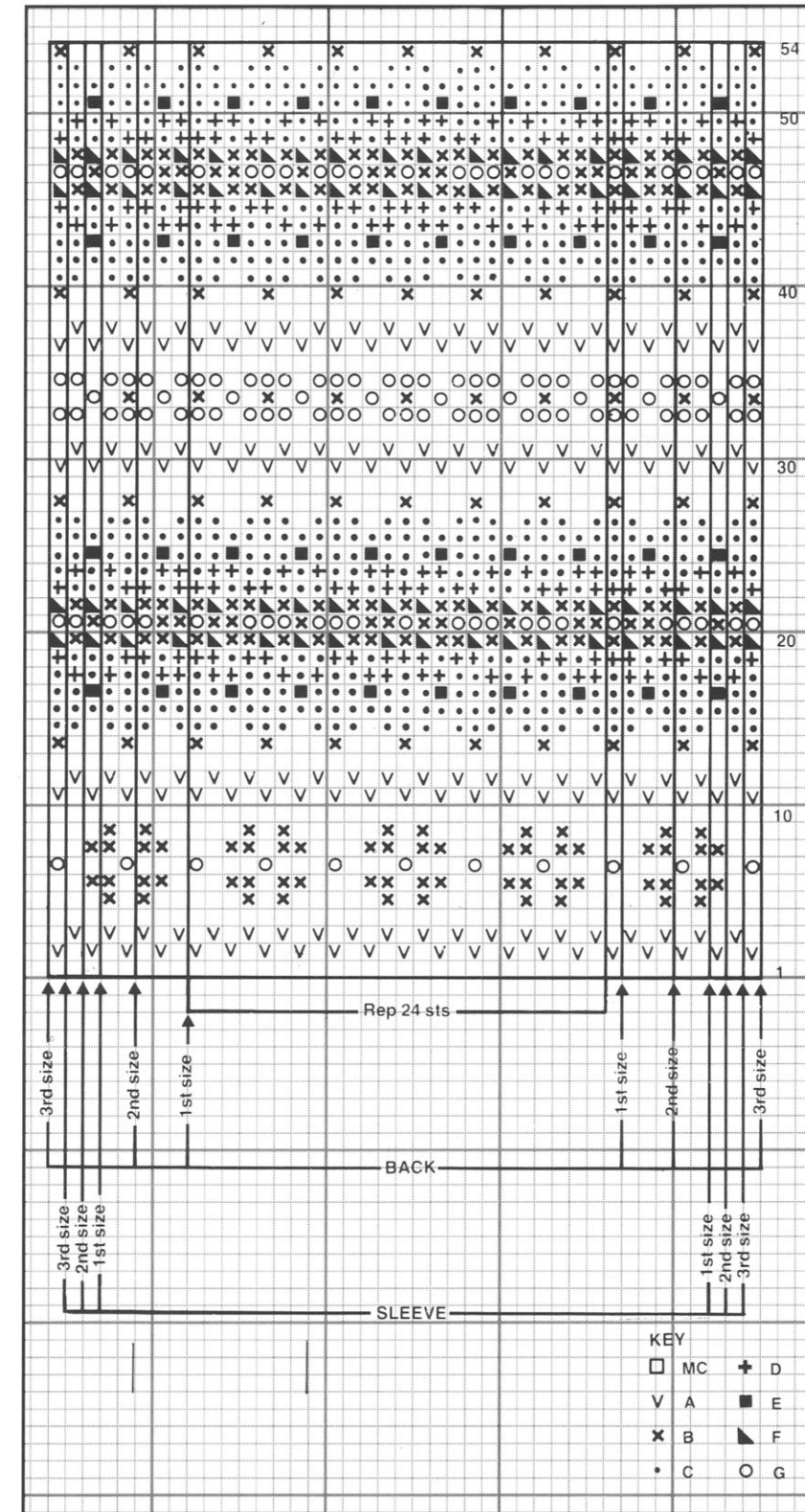

Next row K13 (14:15), M1, K9, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K9, M1, K2. 52 (54:56) sts.

K 5 rows.

Next row K13 (14:15), K2 tog tbl, K7, K2 tog, K28 (29:30).

K 3 rows.

Next row K13 (14:15), K2 tog tbl, K5, K2 tog, K28 (29:30).

K 3 rows.

Next row K13 (14:15), K2 tog tbl, K3, K2 tog, K28 (29:30).

K 1 row.

Next row K12 (13:14), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K27 (28:29).

K 1 row.

Next row K11 (12:13), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K26 (27:28).

K 1 row.

Next row K10 (11:12), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K25 (26:27).

K 1 row.

Next row K9 (10:11), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K24 (25:26).

K 1 row.

Next row K8 (9:10), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K23 (24:25). (36 (38:40) sts.

K 1 row. Change to M and K 1 row.

Work Right Leg as follows:

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. **Next row (wrong side) * [K1, P1] twice, [K1, P1] all in next st; rep from * to last 1 (3:5) sts, [K1, P1] 0 (1:2) times, K1. 43 (45:47) sts.

Next row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

Work a further 3 rows in rib.

Next row Rib 3 (3:2), [M1, rib 1, M1, rib 2] 13 (13:14) times, [M1, rib 2] 0 (1:1) time, rib 1. 69 (72:76) sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and cont in garter st until work measures 9 (11:13) cm/3½ (4¼:5) in from beg of rib, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape crotch

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec one st at beg of next 4 rows.

K 1 row.**

Leave rem 59 (62:66) sts on a holder.

Left Foot

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 32 (34:36) sts. K 1 row.

Next row K2, M1, K1, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K1, M1, K13 (14:15).

K 1 row.

Next row K2, M1, K3, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K3, M1, K13 (14:15).

K 1 row.

Next row K2, M1, K5, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K5, M1, K13 (14:15).

K 1 row.

Next row K2, M1, K7, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K7, M1, K13 (14:15).

K 1 row.

Next row K2, M1, K9, M1, K15 (16:17), M1, K9, M1, K13 (14:15). 52 (54:56) sts.

K 5 rows.

Next row K28 (29:30), K2 tog tbl, K7, K2 tog, K13 (14:15).

K 3 rows.

Next row K28 (29:30), K2 tog tbl, K5, K2 tog, K13 (14:15).

K 3 rows.

Next row K28 (29:30), K2 tog tbl, K3, K2 tog, K13 (14:15).

K 1 row.

Next row K27 (28:29), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K12 (13:14).

K 1 row.

Next row K26 (27:28), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K11 (12:13).

K 1 row.

Next row K25 (26:27), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K10 (11:12).

K 1 row.

Next row K24 (25:26), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K9 (10:11).

K 1 row.

Next row K23 (24:25), K2 tog, K3, K2 tog tbl, K8 (9:10). 36 (38:40) sts.

K 1 row. Change to M and K 1 row.

Now work Left Leg as given for Right Leg, from ** to **.

Next row (wrong side) K to end, then K across sts of Right Leg. 118 (124:132) sts.

Work a further 3 cm/1¼ in in garter st, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape front opening

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 112 (118:126) sts.

Cont straight until work measures 30 (33:36) cm/11¼ (13:14) in from beg of rib, ending with a wrong side row.

Divide for armholes

Next row K26 (28:30) sts and turn; leaving rem sts on a spare needle.

Working on these 26 (28:30) sts only for Right Front, cont in garter st for a further 9 (10:11) cm/3½ (4:4¼) in, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 19 (20:21) sts rem. Cont straight until work measures 44 (48:52) cm/17¼ (19:20½) in from beg of rib, ending with a right side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 10 (10:11) sts at beg of next row. K 1 row. Cast off rem 9 (10:10) sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts and K60 (62:66) sts, turn, leaving rem sts on a spare needle. Working on these sts only for Back, cont in garter st until work measures same as Right Front to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 10 (10:11) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 9 (10:10) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 22 (22:24) sts on a holder.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts for Left Front and K to end.

Complete to match Right Front, reversing shapings.

Left Mitten

***With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 16 sts. K 1 row.

Next row K1, M1, K6, M1, K2, M1, K6, M1, K1. K 1 row.

Next row K1, M1, K8, M1, K2, M1, K8, M1, K1. K 1 row.

Next row K1, M1, K10, M1, K2, M1, K10, M1, K1.

2nd and 3rd sizes only

K 1 row.

Next row K1, M1, K12, M1, K2, M1, K12, M1, K1.

All sizes

K 3 rows.

Next row K1, M1, K12 (16:14), [M1, K2] 1 (0:1) time, M1, K12 (15:14), [M1, K1] 1 (0:1) time. 32 (34:36) sts.

K 25 (29:33) rows. Change to M and K 1 row.***

Work Left Sleeve as follows:

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. **Next row** P0 (1:0), [K1, P1] 8 (8:9) times, turn.

Work on this set of sts only.

Next row [K1, P1] to last 0 (1:0) st, K0 (1:0). Rib 1 row.

1st buttonhole row Rib 3, cast off 1, rib to last 4 sts, cast off 1, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib 3, cast on 1, rib to last 3 sts, cast on 1, rib to end.

Rib 2 rows. Cast off in rib.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and wrong side facing, join M yarn to rem sts, cast on 8 (9:9) sts, P0 (1:1), [K1, P1] to last 0 (1:0) st, K0 (1:0).

Next row Cast on 8 (8:9), P0 (1:1), [K1, P1] to last 0 (1:1) st, K0 (1:1). 32 (34:36) sts. Rib 4 rows.

******Next row** Rib 3 (3:4), M1, [rib 5 (4:3),

M1] to last 4 (3:5) sts, rib to end. 38 (42:46) sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and cont in garter st, inc one st at each end of every foll 3rd (4th:4th) row until there are 62 (66:70) sts. Cont straight until sleeve measures 14 (16:18) cm/5½ (6¼:7) in from beg of rib, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off loosely.

Right Mitten

Work as Left Mitten from *** to ***.

Work Right Sleeve as follows:

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. **Next row** Cast on 8 (9:9) sts, K0 (0:1), [P1, K1] to last 0 (1:0) st, P0 (1:0).

Next row K0 (1:0), [P1, K1] 8 (8:9) times, turn.

Work on this set of sts only. Rib 1 row.

1st buttonhole row Rib 3, cast off 1, rib to last 4 sts, cast off 1, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib 3, cast on 1, rib to last 3 sts, cast on 1, rib to end.

Rib 2 rows. Cast off in rib.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, join M yarn to rem sts, cast on 8 (8:9) sts, K0 (0:1), [P1, K1] to last 0 (0:1) st, P0 (0:1). Rib 4 rows.

Complete as Left Sleeve from **** to end.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 19 (20:21) sts up right front neck, K across 22 (22:24) sts on back neck holder, inc 1 st at centre, pick up and K 19 (20:21) sts down left front neck. 61 (63:67) sts.

1st row (wrong side) P1, [K1, P1] to end.

2nd row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Next row Rib 5 and slip these sts onto a safety pin, rib 5 (5:4), inc in next st, [rib 9 (6:7), inc in next st] to last 10 (10:9) sts, rib 5 (5:4), slip last 5 sts onto a safety pin. 56 (60:64) sts.

Work Hood as follows:

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles. Cont in garter st until work measures 12 (14:16) cm/4¾ (5½:6¼) in from top of rib, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Next row K37 (39:41) sts, K2 tog, turn.

Next row K19, K2 tog tbl, turn.

Next row K19, K2 tog, turn.

Rep last 2 rows until all sts are decreased on either side of hood. Leave rem 20 sts on a holder.

Hood Edging

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and M, rib 5 sts from right side of hood safety pin, pick up and K 26 (29:32) sts up right side of hood, K across sts on holder, dec one st, pick up and K 26 (29:32) sts down left side of hood, rib 5 sts on left side safety pin. 81 (87:93) sts.

Rib 7 rows. Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 89 (99:109) sts evenly along right side edge of front opening to top of hood edging. Work 3

rows in rib as given for neckband.

1st buttonhole row Rib 3, [cast off 2, rib 13 (15:17) sts more] 5 times, cast off 2, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib to end, casting on 2 sts over those cast off in previous row.

Rib 4 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

Work to match Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

To Make Up

Join foot and leg seams, then back crotch seam. Join front crotch and centre seam to front opening. Overlap buttonhole band over button band and catch down to base of opening. Join side seam of mittens, leaving buttonhole band free. Join sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew on buttons to button band and cuffs.*****

Outer Ears (Make 2)

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 5 sts. Work in garter st, inc one st at each end of 2 foll alt rows. 9 sts. Cont straight until work measures 8 cm/3 in from beg. Cast off.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and Dark Grey, work as given for outer ears. Join paired pieces together. Fold cast off edges in half and sew through all thicknesses to each side of hood.

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 16 sts. Work in garter st for 7 cm/2¾ in. Cast off. Fold in half lengthwise and join seam. Attach to top of back crotch seam.

Inner Ears (Make 2)

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and Dark Grey, work as given for outer ears. Join paired pieces together. Fold cast off edges in half and sew through all thicknesses to each side of hood.

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A,

Chick Cardigan and Bootees

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MATERIALS

Cardigan: 3 × 50g balls of Hayfield Raw Cotton Classics 4 ply in main colour (M), 1 × 50g ball of same in contrast colour (A). Small amounts of any 4 ply in 2 contrast colours (B and C).

Bootees: 1 × 50g ball of Hayfield Raw Cotton Classics 4 ply in main colour (M). Small amounts of same in 2 contrast colours (A and B). 1 pair each of 2½ mm (No 12/US 1) and 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) knitting needles.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit age 0–3 months
All round at chest 52 cm 20½ in
Length to shoulder 23 cm 9 in
Sleeve seam 14 cm 5½ in

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm/4 in over st st on 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

See page 39.

NOTE

When working Fair Isle borders, strand yarn not in use loosely across wrong side. Use separate length of yarn for each motif and twist yarns together on wrong side when changing colour to avoid holes.

Cardigan

Main Part (work in one piece to armholes). With 2½ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and B, cast on 141 sts. Change to M.

1st row (right side) K1, [P1, K1] to end. Change to A.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

With A, cont in rib until work measures 3 cm/1¼ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M.

Work border patt as follows: Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, work 2 rows.

3rd row 1C, [1M, 1C] to end.

4th row 1M, [1C, 1M] to end.

Work 4 rows in M.

9th row 1M, [1C, 1M, 1B, 1M] to end.

10th row 1B, [1M, 1B] to end.

11th row 1M, [1B, 1M, 1A, 1M] to end.

12th row As 10th row.

13th row As 9th row.

Now work patt from chart, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right.

1st row Work across 1st row of chart as follows: 35 sts from W to X, then 71 sts from W to Z and 35 sts from Y to Z.

2nd row Work across 2nd row of chart as follows: 35 sts from Z to Y, then 71 sts from

Z to W and 35 sts from X to W.

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of chart until work measures 13 cm/5 in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Divide for armholes

Next row Patt 35, turn. Work on these 35 sts only for Right Front.

Keeping patt correct, cont without shaping until work measures 20 cm/8 in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row. Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 24 sts rem.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures 23 cm/9 in from beg, ending with a right side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 12 sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 12 sts.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt 71 sts, turn. Work on these 71 sts only for Back. Cont without shaping until Back measures same as Right Front to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 12 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Leave rem 23 sts on a holder.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn to rem 35 sts for Left Front and patt to end. Complete to match Right Front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves

With 2½ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and B, cast on 37 sts.

Change to M and work in rib as given for Back for 1 row. Change to A and cont in rib until work measures 3 cm/1¼ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row and inc 8 sts evenly across last row. 45 sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Work border patt as given for Back, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of every foll 3rd row. Work 7 rows in M only, inc one st at each end of 2nd and foll 3rd row. 57 sts.

Now work patt from chart as follows:

1st row With M, K twice in first st, K10, work across 35 sts of 23rd row of chart from W to X, with M, K10, K twice in last st.

2nd row P12 M, work across 35 sts of 24th row of chart from X to W, P12 M.

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set until 35th row of chart has been worked, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of 2nd and foll 3rd row, working inc sts in M. 63 sts.

Cont without shaping and M only for a few rows until work measures 14 cm/5½ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. With 2½ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, M and right side facing,

pick up and K 20 sts up right front neck, K across 23 sts on back neck, pick up and K 20 sts down left front neck. 63 sts. Change to A and work 9 rows in rib as given for Back. Change to M and rib 1 row. Change to B and cast off in rib.

Buttonhole Band

With 2½ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 63 sts evenly along front edge of Right Front. Change to A, work 4 rows in rib as given for Back.

1st buttonhole row Rib 3, [cast off 2, rib 6 sts more] 6 times, cast off 2, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib to end, casting on 2 sts over those cast off in previous row. Rib 3 rows. Change to M and rib 1 row. Change to B and cast off in rib.

Button Band

Work to match Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

To Make Up

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. With B and straight stitch (see diagram page 70), embroider legs, feet, eyes and beaks on chicks.

Bootees

With M only, work as Bootees of Striped Sweater with Zig Zag Collar (see page 44) until the strap has been completed. Using B, complete to match Bootees of Striped Sweater with Zig Zag Collar, omitting edging. With A, make 2 pompons and attach one to each Bootee.

'Chanel' Jacket

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MATERIALS

4 (5:6) 50g balls of Hayfield Pure Wool Classics DK.
1 pair of 4 mm (No 8/US 5) knitting needles.
Medium size crochet hook.
8 buttons.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit age

6–12 (12–24:24–36) months

All round at chest

59 (64:69) cm 23¼ (25¼:27¼) in

Length to shoulder

26 (30:34) cm 10¼ (11¼:13½) in

Sleeve seam

16 (20:24) cm 6¼ (8:9½) in

TENSION

23 sts and 38 rows to 10 cm/4 in over moss st on 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

See page 39.

Back

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 67 (73:79) sts.

1st row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

This row forms moss st patt. Cont in moss st until work measures 26 (30:34) cm/10¼ (11¼:13½) in from beg.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 10 (11:12) sts at beg of next 4 rows. Cast off rem 27 (29:31) sts.

Pocket Flaps (Make 4)

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 17 sts.

Work 10 rows in moss st patt as given for Back. Leave these sts on a holder.

Left Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 37 (41:43) sts.

Cont in moss st patt as given for Back until work measures 8 (9:10) cm/3 (3½:4) in from beg, ending at side edge.

**Place pocket flap

Next row (right side) Moss st 8 (10:10) sts, now place one pocket flap sts in front of work, then taking one st from each needle and working them together, moss st across these 17 sts, moss st to end.**

Cont in moss st until work measures 20 (23:26) cm/8 (9:10¼) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Rep from ** to ** once more.

Cont in moss st until work measures 22 (26:30) cm/8¾ (10¼:11¼) in from beg, ending at front edge.

Shape neck

Cast off 7 (9:9) sts at beg of next row.

Keeping moss st correct, dec one st at neck edge on every row until 20 (22:24) sts rem. Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 10 (11:12) sts at beg of next row.

Moss st 1 row. Cast off rem 10 (11:12) sts. Mark front edge with pins indicating buttons, first one to come 7 (8:9) cm/2¾ (3:3½) in up from cast on edge and last one 1 cm/¼ in down from neck edge and rem 2 spaced evenly between.

Right Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 37 (41:43) sts.

Cont in moss st patt as given for Back until work measures 7 (8:9) cm/2¾ (3:3½) in from beg, ending at front edge.

1st buttonhole row (right side) Moss st 2, cast off 3, moss st to end.

2nd buttonhole row Moss st to end, casting on 3 sts over those cast off in previous row. Moss st 2 rows.

***Place pocket flap

Next row Moss st 12 (14:16), now place one pocket flap sts in front of work, then taking one st from each needle and working them together, moss st across these 17 sts, moss st to end.***

Complete to match Left Front, making 3 more buttonholes at pin positions as before and placing 2nd flap as given from *** to ***.

Sleeves

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 37 (39:41) sts.

Work in moss st patt as given for Back, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of every foll 5th (6th:7th) row until there are 53 (57:61) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 16 (20:24) cm/6¼ (8:9½) in from beg. Cast off.

To Make Up

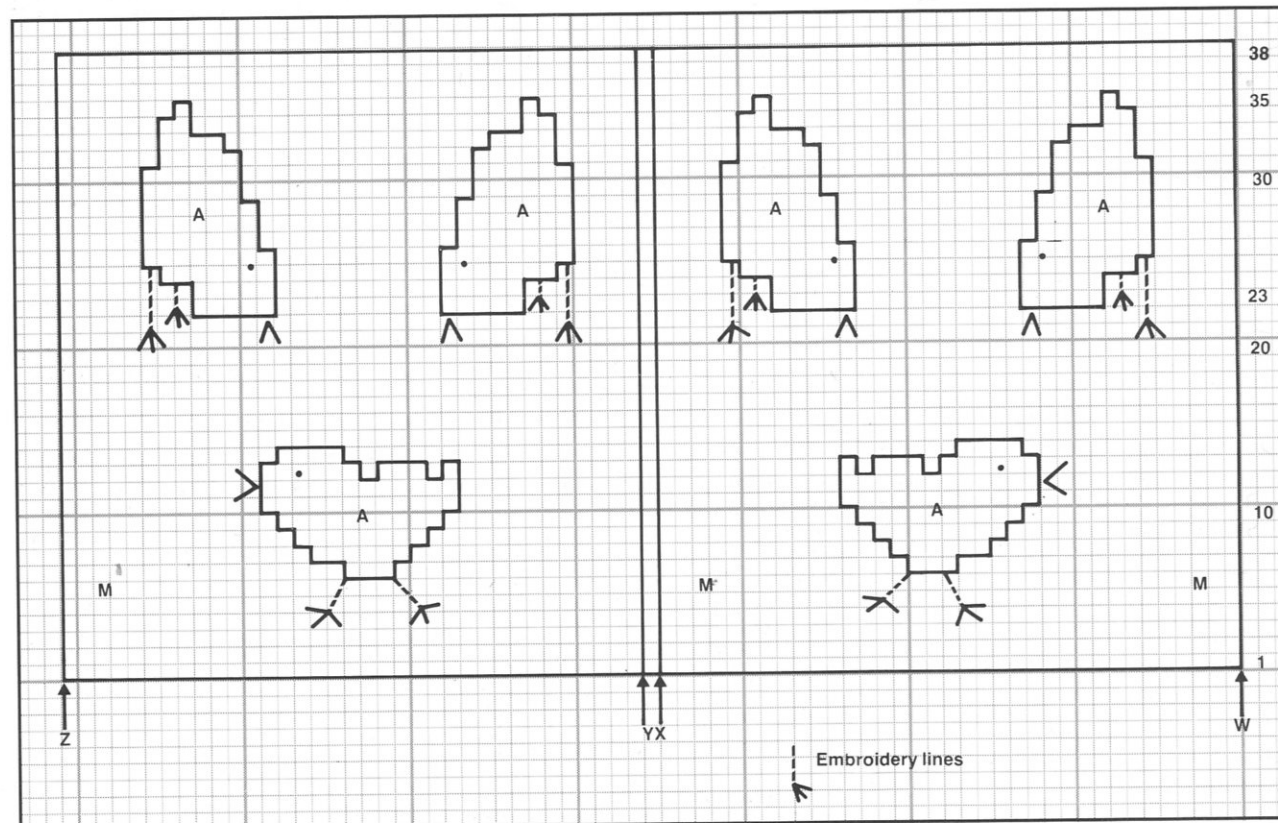
Join shoulder seams. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams.

Crochet edging

With crochet hook and right side facing, work 1 row of double crochet along cast on edge of Back, Right Front, up Right Front, around neck, down Left Front, then along cast on edge of Left Front. DO NOT TURN. Now work 1 row of backward double crochet (double crochet worked from left to right-corded st). Fasten off.

Work crochet edging along cast on edge of Sleeves and round 3 free edges of each Pocket Flap.

Sew on 4 buttons to front edge of Left Front and one to centre of each Flap.

side row and inc 6 sts evenly across last row. 77 (83:89) sts.
Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.
Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Back, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right, until 76 (84:94) rows of patt in all have been worked.

Shape shoulders

Left Front

Work as given for Left Front, reversing all shaping and working patt from chart as indicated for Right Front.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 37 (39:41) sts.
Work in rib as given for Back for 3 cm/1¼ in, ending with a wrong side row and inc 6 sts evenly across last row. 43 (45:47) sts.

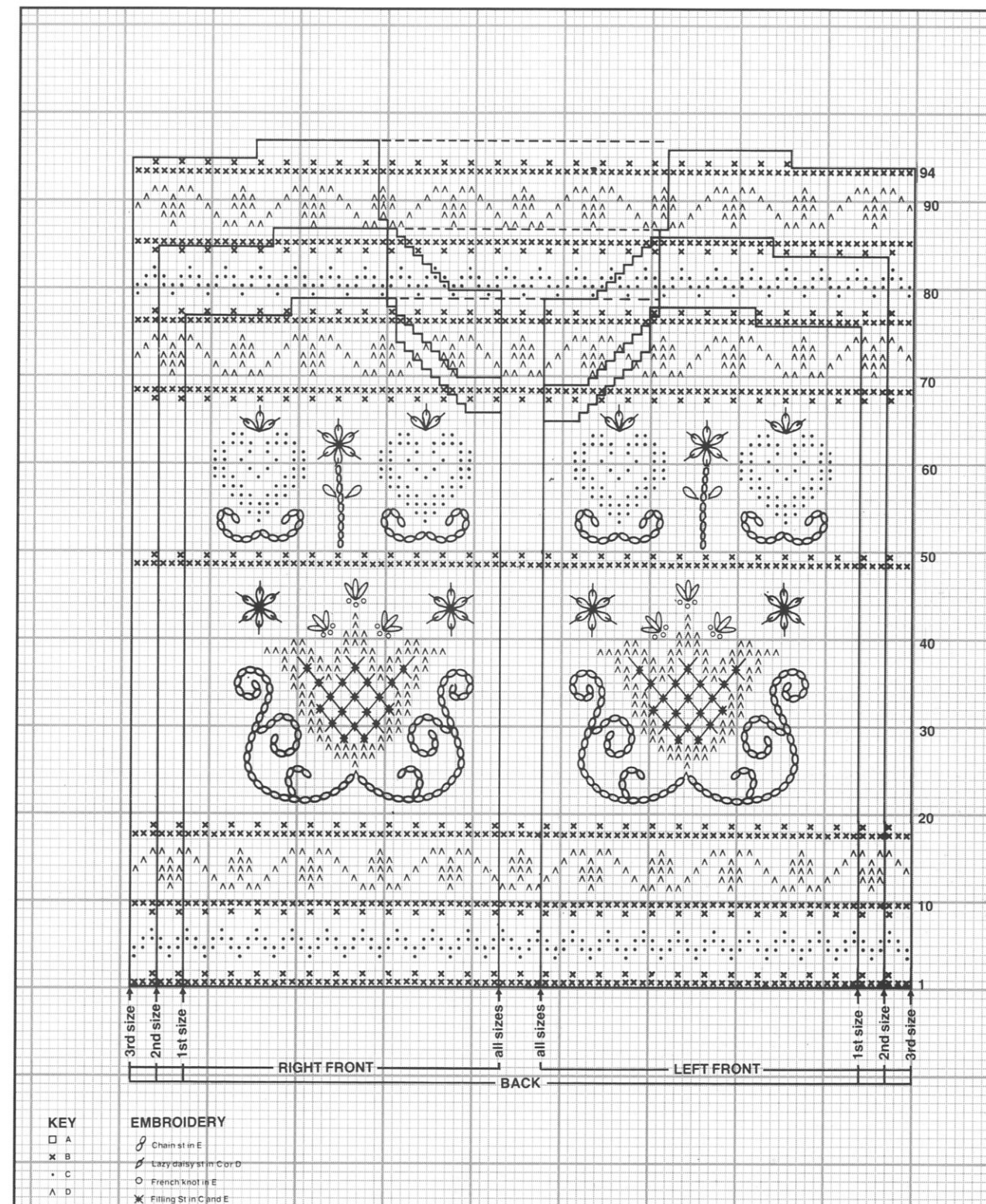
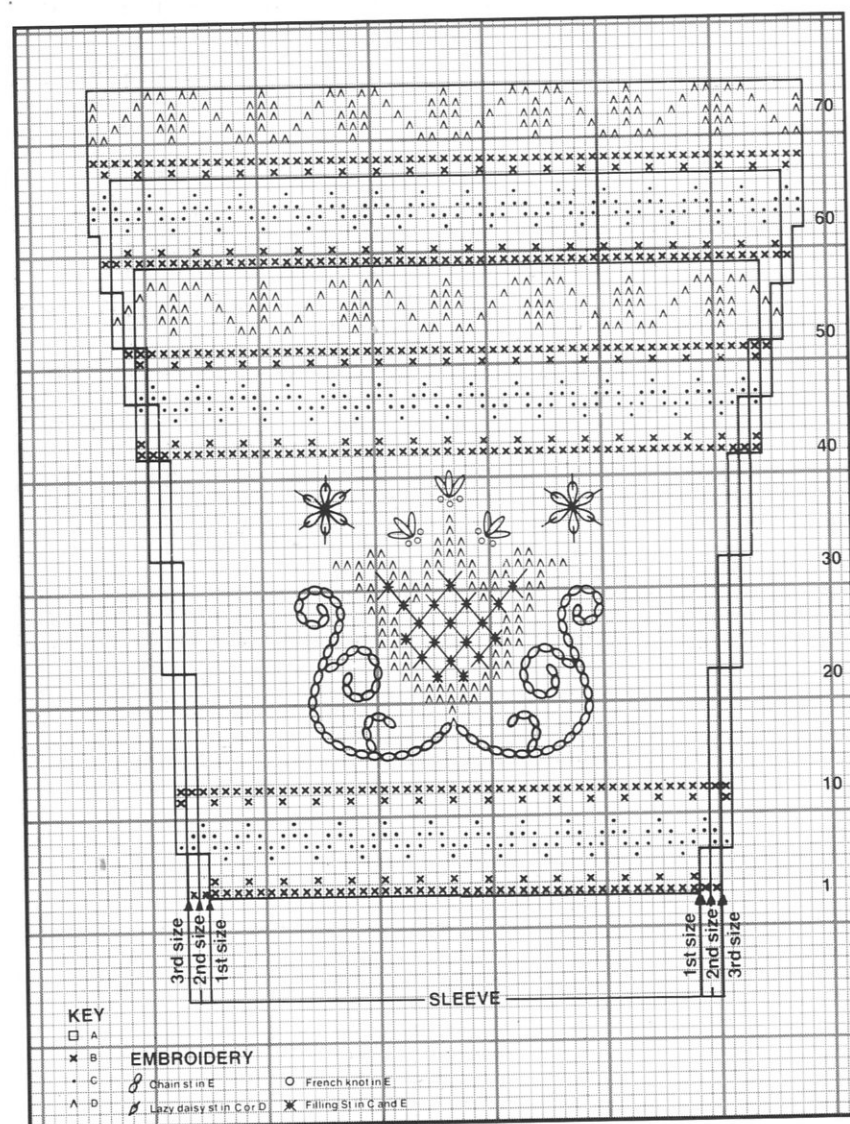

Work 9 rows in rib as given for Back. Cast off in rib.



Buttonhole Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and A, pick up and K 73 (81:89) sts evenly along straight edge of Right Front to top of neckband.
Beg with a 2nd row, work 3 rows in rib as given for Back.

Buttonhole row Rib 3, [P2 tog, yrn, rib 14 (16:18) sts] 4 times, P2 tog, yrn, rib to end. Rib 4 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

Work to match Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

To Make Up

Work embroidery in colours and stitches as indicated on chart. (See pages 61, 70 & 75 for diagrams.)
Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Back

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 85 (93) sts. Beg with a K row, work 7 rows in st st.

Next row K to end for hem line.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Back, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right, until work measures 35 (38) cm/13¾ (15) in from hem line, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row Patt 34 (36), cast off next 17 (21) sts, patt to end. Cont on last set of sts only. Patt 1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row and foll alt row. Cast off rem 28 (30) sts.

With wrong side facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off 3 sts, patt to end. Patt 1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. Cast off rem 28 (30) sts.

Right Front

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 47 (51) sts. Beg with a K row, work 7 rows in st st.

Next row K to end for hem line.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Right Front until work measures 10 cm/4 in from hem line, ending with a wrong side row.

1st buttonhole row Patt 3, cast off 2, patt to end.

2nd buttonhole row Patt to last 3 sts, cast on 2, patt 3.

Patt 8 rows.

Rep last 10 rows once more then work the 2 buttonhole rows again.

Cont in patt for a few rows until work measures 19 (20) cm/7½ (8) in from hem line, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Keeping patt correct, cast off 5 sts at beg of next row.

Dec one st at neck edge on 9 foll right side rows then on every 3rd row until 28 (30) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to cast off edge, ending at side edge. Cast off.

Left Front

Following chart as indicated for Left Front, work as given for Right Front, omitting buttonholes and reversing neck shaping.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 38 (42) sts. Work 5 cm/2 in in K1, P1 rib inc 7 (3) sts evenly along last row. 45 sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Work in patt as given for 2nd size on Back, at the same time inc one st at each end of 5th row, then on every foll 3rd row until there are 71 (75) sts, working inc sts into patt.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures 25 (28) cm/10 (11) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Collar

Join shoulder seams.

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and B, cast on 13 (15) sts.

Beg with a P row, work 7 (5) rows in st st inc one st at each end of every K row. 19 sts. Next row (right side) With B, K twice in first st, K 1M, [3B, 1M] to last st, with B, K twice in last st.

Next row P 1B, [3M, 1B] to end.

With M, work 3 rows in st st inc one st at each end of every K row. 25 sts.

Beg with 60th row, cont in st st and patt from chart as indicated for Collar, at the same time, inc one st at each end of every alt row until there are 55 (61) sts, working inc sts into patt.

Patt 1 (5) rows straight.

Shape collar

Cont in M as follows:

1st row K to last 6 (7) sts, yf, sl 1, yb, turn.
2nd row Sl 1, P to last 6 (7) sts, yb, sl 1, yf, turn.

3rd row Sl 1, K to last 12 (14) sts, yf, sl 1, yb, turn.

4th row Sl 1, P to last 12 (14) sts, yb, sl 1, yf, turn.

5th row Sl 1, K to last 18 (21) sts, yf, sl 1, yb, turn.

6th row Sl 1, P to last 18 (21) sts, yb, sl 1, yf,

turn.

7th row Sl 1, K to last 24 (28) sts, yf, sl 1, yb, turn.

8th row Sl 1, P to last 24 (28) sts, yb, sl 1, yf, turn.

Work 2 rows across all sts.

Next 2 rows As 7th and 8th rows.

Next 2 rows As 5th and 6th rows.

Next 2 rows As 3rd and 4th rows.

Next 2 rows As 1st and 2nd rows.

Cont without shaping until this half of collar fits up right front neck to centre back neck. Work the other half of collar to match first half, but working decreases instead of increases. Cast off 13 (15) sts.

Right Front Facing

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 7 sts. Beg with a K row, cont in st st until work measures 7 cm/2¾ in, ending with a P row.

1st buttonhole row K3, cast off 2, K to end. 2nd buttonhole row P2, cast on 2, P3.

Work 8 rows.

Rep last 10 rows once more then work the 2 buttonhole rows again. Work 2 (4) rows. Cast off.

Left Front Facing

Work as Right Front Facing, omitting buttonholes.

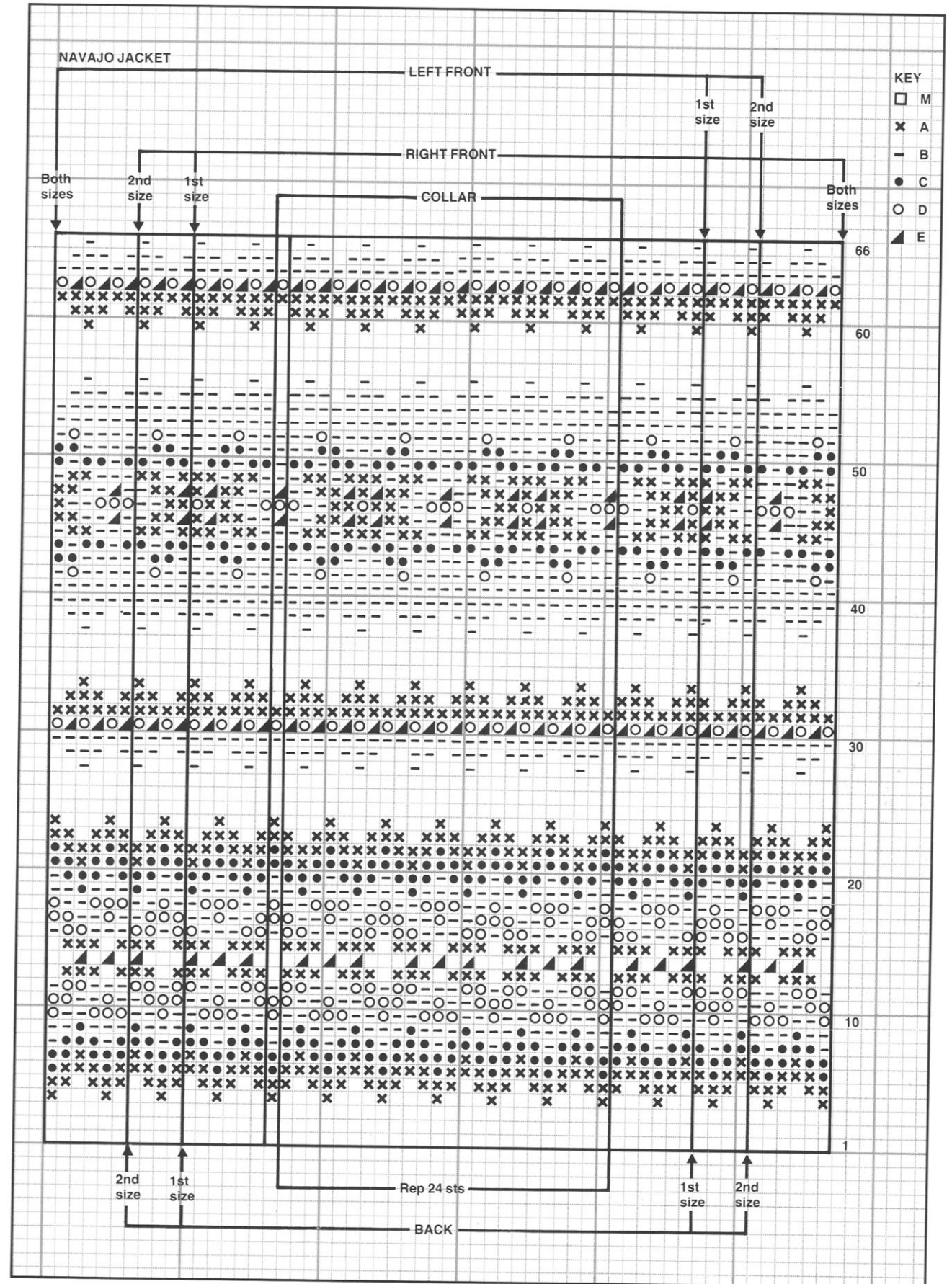

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Turn hem to wrong side and slip stitch in position. Close opening at front edges.

Beg at top of hem, join facings to front edges, matching buttonholes.

With right sides together, sew one long edge of collar in place, matching patterns and sewing cast on/cast off sts of collar to top of facings and sts cast off at neck edge.

Turn collar and facings to wrong side and slip stitch in position. Catch down facings to hem. Neaten buttonholes. Sew on buttons.

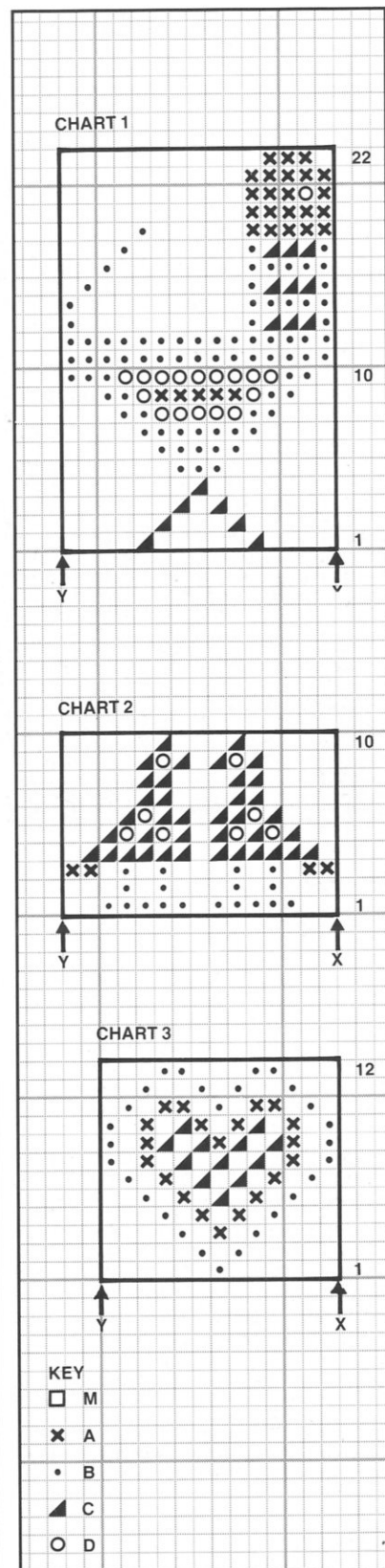

Beg with a P row, cont in st st and M only until work measures 26 (31) cm/10¼ (12¼) in from beg, ending with a P row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 11 (12) sts at beg of next 4 rows. Leave rem 27 (31) sts on a holder.

Left Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and M, cast on 35 (39) sts.

Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back.

Next row K to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

Next row Moss st 4, P to end.

Work lower border patt as follows:

1st row (right side) K1A, [3M, 1A] to last 6 sts, with M, K2, moss st 4.

2nd row With M, moss st 4, P1M, [1A, 1M] to end.

3rd row K1B, 1M, 1A, [1M, 1B, 1M, 1A] to last 4 sts, with M, moss st 4.

4th row As 2nd row.

5th row As 1st row.

Work front edge border patt as follows:

1st row (wrong side) With M, moss st 4, [P1 M, 1A] twice, with M, P to end.

2nd row With M, K to last 9 sts, K1A, 1M, 1B, 1M, 1A, with M, moss st 4.

3rd row As 1st row.

4th row With M, K to last 7 sts, K1A, with M, K2, moss st 4.

These 4 rows form front edge border patt.

Now work motif from chart 1 as follows:

1st row (wrong side) Border patt 9, P6 M, P across 15 sts from X to Y (thus reversing motif) of row 1 of chart 1, P5 (9) M.

2nd row K5 (9) M, K across 15 sts from Y to X of row 2 of chart 1, K6M, border patt 9.

3rd to 22nd rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows 10 times more, but working 3rd to 22nd rows of chart 1.

Next row Border patt 9, with M, P to end.

Next row With M, K to last 9 sts, border patt 9.

Rep last 2 rows until work measures approximately 16 (20) cm/6¼ (8) in from beg, ending with a 1st row of front edge border patt.

Work motif from chart 3 as follows:

1st row (right side) K6 (10) M, K across 13 sts from X to Y of row 1 of chart 3, K7M, border patt 9.

2nd row Border patt 9, P7M, P across 13 sts from Y to X of row 2 of chart 3, P6 (10) M.

3rd to 12th rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows 5 times more, but working 3rd to 12th rows of chart 3.

Next row With M, K to last 9 sts, border patt 9.

Next row Border patt 9, with M, P to end. Work a further 1 (5) rows as set.

Keeping moss st at front edge, cont in M only, work 2 rows.

Shape neck

Cast off 5 (6) sts at beg of next row and 3 (4) sts at beg of foll alt row. Dec one st at neck edge on next 5 rows. 22 (24) sts.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 11 (12) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 11 (12) sts.

Right Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and M, cast on 35 (39) sts.

Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back.

Next row Moss st 4, K to end.

Work lower border patt as follows:

1st row (right side) With M, moss st 4, K2, [1A, 3M] to last st, 1A.

2nd row P1M, [1A, 1M] to last 4 sts, with M, moss st 4.

3rd row With M, moss st 4, K1A, [1M, 1B, 1M, 1A] to last 2 sts, 1M, 1B.

4th row As 2nd row.

5th row As 1st row.

Work front edge border patt as follows:

1st row (wrong side) With M, P to last 8 sts, [P1A, 1M] twice, with M, moss st 4.

2nd row With M, moss st 4, K1A, 1M, 1B, 1M, 1A, with M, K to end.

3rd row As 1st row.

4th row With M, moss st 4, K2M, 1A, with M, K to end.

These 4 rows form front edge border patt.

Now work motif from chart 1 as follows:

1st row (wrong side) P5 (9) M, P across 15 sts from Y to X of row 1 of chart 1, P6M, border patt 9.

2nd row Border patt 9, K6M, K across 15 sts from X to Y of row 2 of chart 1, K5 (9) M.

3rd to 22nd rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows 10 times more, but working 3rd to 22nd rows of chart 1.

Next row With M, P to last 9 sts, border patt 9.

Next row Border patt 9, with M, K to end. Rep last 2 rows until work measures approximately 16 (20) cm/6¼ (8) in from beg, ending with a 1st row of front edge border patt.

Work motif from chart 3 as follows:

1st row (right side) Border patt 9, K7M, K across 13 sts from X to Y of row 1 of chart 3, K6 (10) M.

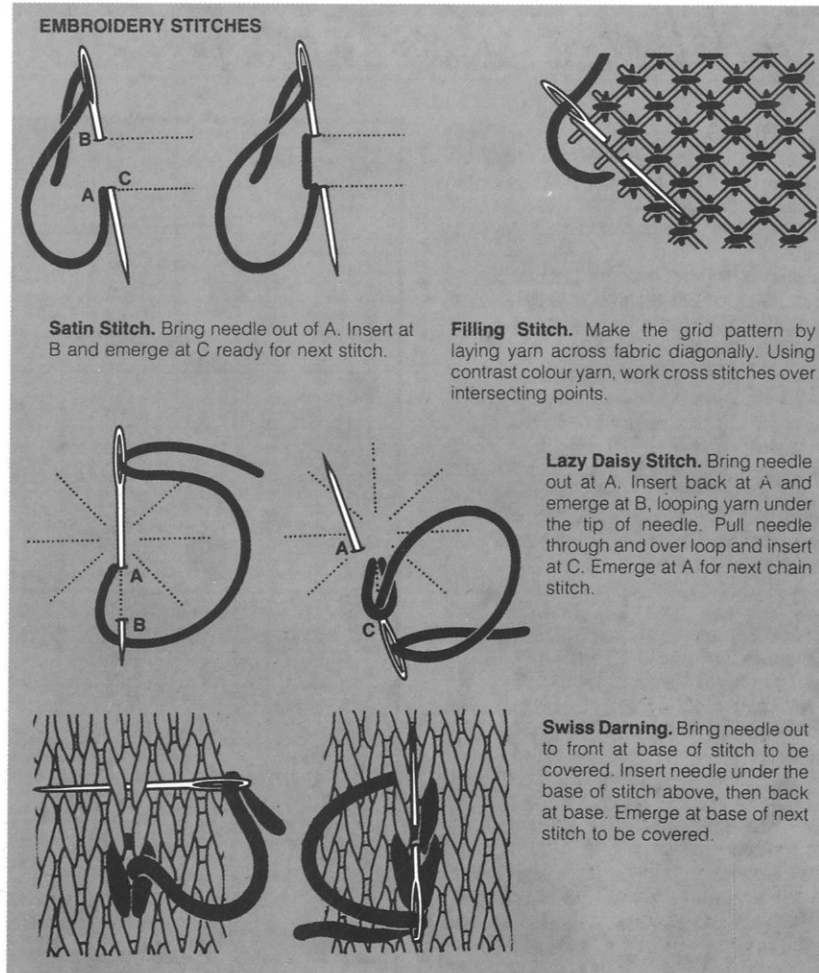
2nd row P6 (10) M, P across 13 sts from Y to X of row 2 of chart 3, P7M, border patt 9.

3rd to 12th rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows 5 times more, but working 3rd to 12th rows of chart 3.

Next row Border patt 9, with M, K to end.

Next row With M, P to last 9 sts, border patt 9. Work a further 1 (5) rows as set. Keeping moss st at front edge, cont in M only, work 1 row.

Complete as Left Front.



Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 37 (41) sts.

Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back. Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Beg with a K row, work 2 rows in st st, inc one st at each end of last row. 39 (43) sts.

Work border patt as given for Back from ** to **.

Beg with a P row, work 4 rows in st st and M only, inc one st at each end of first row. 41 (45) sts.

Now work motif from chart 2 as follows:

1st row (wrong side) P13 (15) M, P across 15 sts from Y to X of row 1 of chart 2, P13 (15) M.

2nd row K13 (15) M, K across 15 sts from X to Y of row 2 of chart 2, K13 (15) M.

3rd to 10th rows Rep 1st and 2nd rows 4 times more, but working 3rd to 10th rows of chart 2 and inc and work in M one st at each end of first and seventh rows. 45 (49) sts.

Beg P row, cont in st st and M only, at the same time, inc one st at each end of 5th and foll 6th row. 49 (53) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 17 (20) cm/6¾ (8) in from beg, ending with a P row. Cast off.

Neckband
Join shoulder seams.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, right side facing and M, pick up and K 22 sts up right front neck, K across 27 (31) sts on back neck, pick up and K 22 sts down left front neck. 71 (75) sts.
Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back. Cast off in moss st.

To Make Up

Using B, work 5 lazy daisy stitches (see diagram above) on top of each head for cockscombe. Work 3 lazy daisy stitches in A at end of each tail, then fill centre of each stitch with satin stitch.

Embroider beak with C and crop in B.

Work Swiss Darning if necessary (see diagram above).

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams.

Crochet edging

With crochet hook, right side facing and B, work 1 row of double crochet along cast on edge of Back, Right Front, up Right Front, around neck and down Left Front, then along cast on edge of Left Front. DO NOT TURN. Now work 1 row of backwards double crochet (double crochet worked from left to right-corded st). Fasten off.

Work crochet edging in B along cast on edge of sleeves.

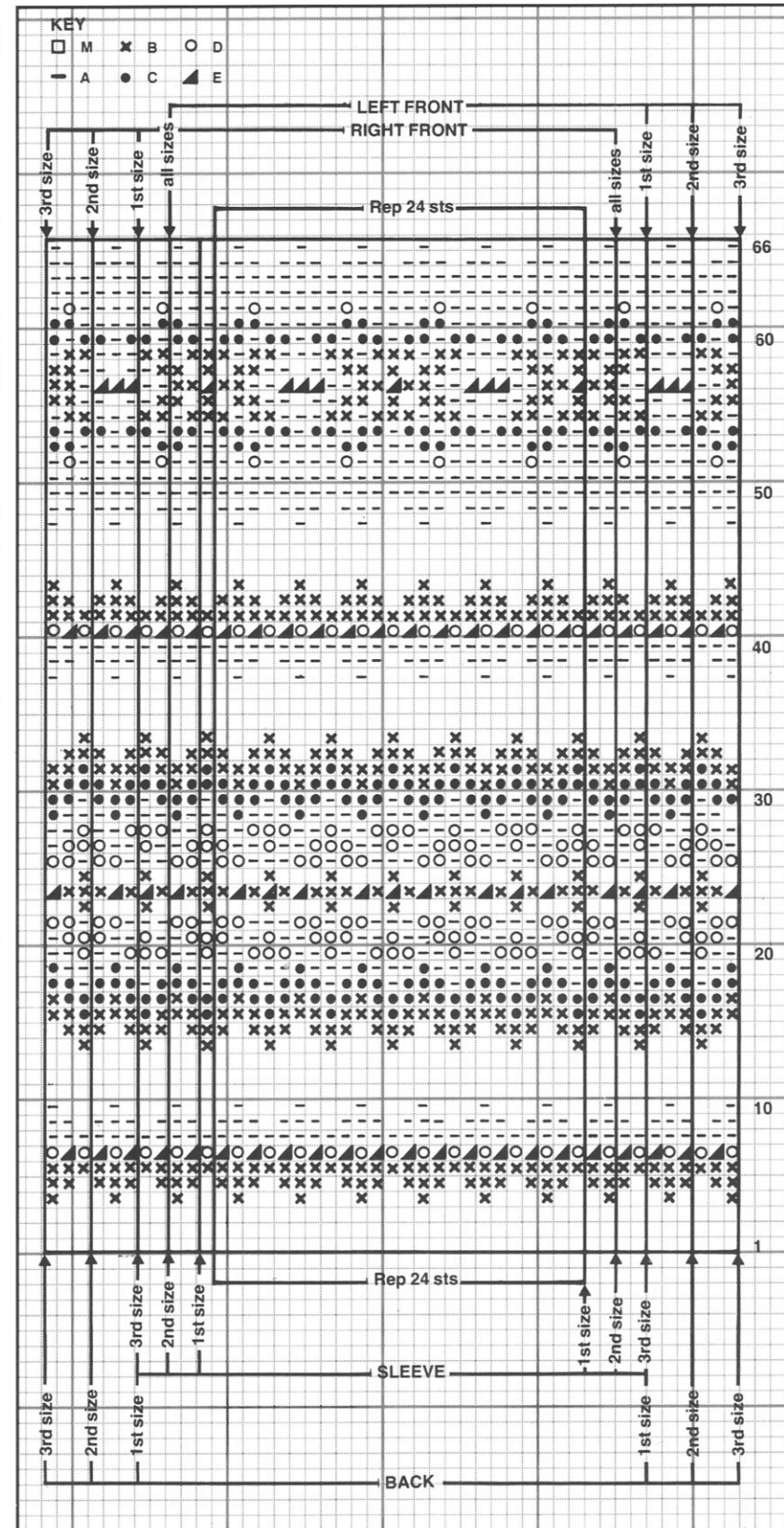

Left Front

Following chart as indicated for Left Front, work as given for Right Front, reversing buttonhole rows and all shaping.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 41 (45:49) sts.

1st row (right side) K1, [P1, K1] to end.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

Rep these 2 rows until work measures 4 cm/1½ in from beg, ending with a wrong side row and inc 8 sts evenly across last row. 49 (53:57) sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Sleeves, at the same time, inc one st at each end of 3rd (4th:4th) and 3 foll alt rows then on every 3rd row until there are 69 (73:79) sts, working inc sts into patt. Cont without shaping until work measures 21 (23:25) cm/8¼ (9:10) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Front Facings (Make 2)

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 9 sts.

Work 8.5 cm/3½ in in st st, ending with a P row.

1st buttonhole row K 3, cast off 3, K to end.

2nd buttonhole row P 3, cast on 3, P to end.

Work 10 (12:14) rows, then rep the 2 buttonhole rows again. Work 2 rows. Cast off.

To Make Up

Join shoulder seams. Join back, top and inside back seam of hood. Fold hood in half to inside, folding shaped part of collar to wrong side of fronts. Join cast on edges of hood to back neck then slip stitch collar in position. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams.

Fold hem to wrong side and slip stitch in place, closing opening at front edges. Sew on facings, sewing cast on edges to top of hem and cast off edges to cast on sts for collar. Neaten buttonholes. Sew on 2 buttons to right side of Left Front and 2 to wrong side of Right Front to correspond with buttonholes, then sew 2 buttons to right side of Right Front in same place as buttons on wrong side.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 (5:5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at each end of every row until 88 (92:96) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures 31 (34:37) cm/12¼ (13¼:14½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 9 (10:10) sts at beg of next 4 rows and 9 (9:10) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 34 (34:36) sts on a holder.

Left Front

With 2¾ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and M, cast on 42 (46:50) sts. Work in rib as given for Back for 4 cm/1½ in, ending with a right side row.

Next row Rib 3 (5:6), inc in next st, [rib 4 (4:5), inc in next st] to last 3 (5:7) sts, rib to end. 50 (54:57) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Work in patt as follows:

1st row (right side) P4 (8:11), [work 1st row of Panel A, then Panel B] twice.

2nd row [Work 2nd row of Panel B, then Panel A] twice, K4 (8:11).

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels until work measures same as Back to armhole shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 4 (5:5) sts at beg of next row. Dec one st at armhole edge on every row until 42 (44:46) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures 27 (30:33) cm/10¾ (11¾:13) in from beg, ending with a right side row.

Shape neck

Cast off 8 (8:9) sts at beg of next row. Dec one st at neck edge on next 7 rows. 27 (29:30) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 9 (10:10) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 9 (9:10) sts.

Right Front

Work as given for Left Front, reversing all shaping and patt as follows:

1st row (right side) [Work 1st row of Panel B, then Panel A] twice, P4 (8:11).

2nd row K4 (8:11), [work 2nd row of Panel A, then Panel B] twice.

Sleeves

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and M, cast on 38 (42:42) sts. Work in rib as given for Back for 4 cm/1½ in, ending with a right side row.

Next row Rib 2 (4:4), [inc in next st, rib 1 (2:1), inc in next st, rib 2] to last 1 (2:3) sts, rib to end. 52 (54:56) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Work in patt as follows:

1st row (right side) P1 (2:3), work 1st row of Panel A, [work 1st row of Panel B, then Panel A] twice, P1 (2:3).

2nd row K1 (2:3), work 2nd row of Panel A, [work 2nd row of Panel B, then Panel A] twice, K1 (2:3).

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set,

working appropriate rows of Panels, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of next and every foll 4th row until there are 72 (80:86) sts, working inc sts into reverse st st.

Cont without shaping until work measures 19 (22:25) cm/7½ (8¾:10) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 (5:5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec one st at each end of next 7 rows, then on every foll alt row until 28 (30:32) sts rem, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Buttonhole Band

With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, right side facing and M, pick up and K 78 (86:94) sts evenly along front edge of Right Front. Work 3 rows in rib as given for Back.

1st buttonhole row Rib 3, [cast off 3, rib 15 (17:19) sts more] 3 times, cast off 3, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib to end, casting on 3 sts over those cast off in previous row. Rib 4 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

Work to match Buttonhole Band, omitting buttonholes.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. With 2¼ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 32 (32:33) sts across Buttonhole Band and up right front neck, K across 34 (34:36) sts at back neck, pick up and K 32 (32:33) sts down left front neck and across Button Band. 98 (98:102) sts.

Work 3 rows in rib as given for Back. **1st buttonhole row** Rib 2, cast off 3, rib to end. **2nd buttonhole row** Rib to last 2 sts, cast on 3, rib to end.

Rib 4 rows. Cast off in rib.

To Make Up

With DK yarn, embroider flowers and leaves in lazy daisy stitch with french knot (see pages 61, 75) in centre between bobbles of Panel B. Join side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves. Sew on buttons.

NOTE

Use a separate length of yarn for each section and twist yarns together on wrong side when changing colour to avoid holes. If preferred, small areas of contrast may be Swiss Darned when knitting is complete.

Back

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 77 sts.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Back, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right, until 46 rows in all have been worked.

Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 67 sts.

Cont without shaping until 84 rows in all have been worked.

Shape shoulders

Cont in A only, cast off 10 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Cast off rem 27 sts.

Left Front

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 37 sts.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Left Front until 44 rows in all have been worked.

Shape front

Keeping patt correct, dec one st at end (front edge) of next row. Patt 1 row.

Shape armhole

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row. 31 sts. Keeping armhole edge straight, cont dec one st at front edge on next and every foll 3rd row until 20 sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulder

Cont in A only, cast off 10 sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 10 sts.

Right Front

Work as given for Left Front, reversing all shaping and working patt from chart as indicated for Right Front.

Sleeves

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and A, cast on 43 sts.

Beg with a K row and working in st st throughout, cont in patt from chart as indicated for Sleeve, *at the same time*, inc one st at each end of 7th and every foll 6th row until there are 59 sts.

Cont without shaping, completing motifs already started only, work a further 9 rows. With A, work 2 rows. Cast off.

To Make Up

Join shoulder seams. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams and sewing last 2 cm/¾ in of row ends of sleeve tops to cast off sts at armholes. Join side and sleeve seams.

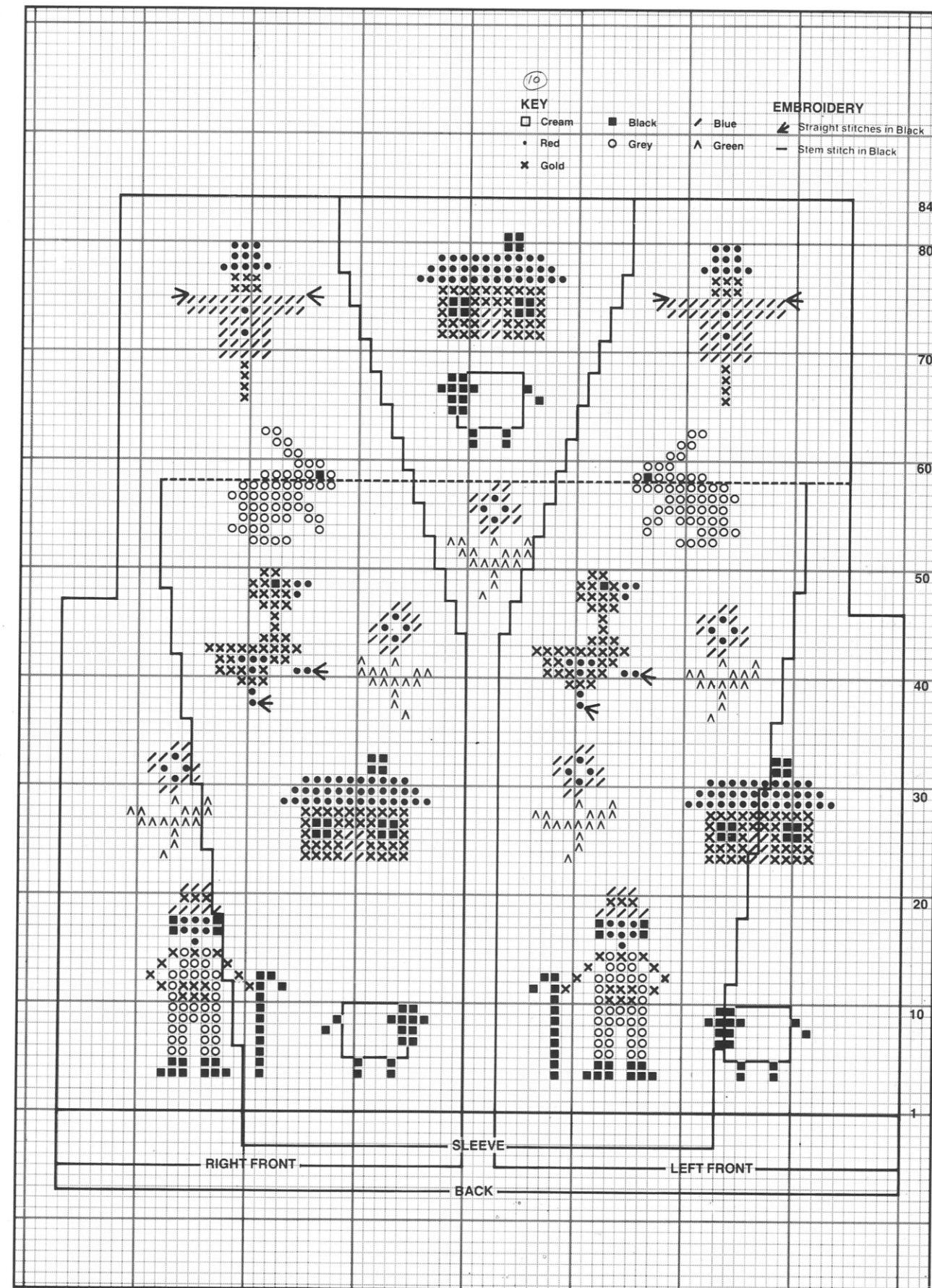
Crochet edging

With crochet hook, A, right side facing and beg at Right Front side seam, work 1 row or double crochet (the number of double crochet should be divisible by 3) along cast on edge of Right Front, up Right Front, across back neck, down Left Front, along cast on edge of Left Front and Back, slip stitch in first double crochet.

Next round [2 treble in same double crochet, slip stitch in next double crochet] to end, making 4 buttonhole loops along straight edge of Right Front by working 3 chain, miss 2 double crochet, slip stitch in next double crochet. Fasten off.

Work edging in same way along cast on edge of sleeves. Sew on buttons.

If necessary work Swiss Darning. Work embroidery with colour and stitches as indicated on chart. (See diagrams page 70.)

Next row Cast on 3, K3 (part of 1st row of Panel C), work 3rd row of Panel D.

Next row Work 4th row of Panel D, P2, inc in next st.

Inc one st at beg (inside edge) of next row and at same edge on every row until there are 42 sts, working inc sts into Panel C, D and B.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work fits along shaped edge of Left Front, ending with a 1st row of Panel C.

Shape collar

Next row Patt 8, turn.

Next row and 6 foll alt rows Slip 1, patt to end.

Next row Patt 25, turn.

Next row Patt 33, turn.

Next row Patt 42.

Next row Patt 33, turn.

Next row Patt 25, turn.

Next row Patt 8, turn.

Patt 1 row, thus ending at inside edge. Cast on 4 sts at beg of next and 2 foll alt rows, working cast on sts into Panels D and C. 54 sts.** Patt 1 row. Leave these sts on a spare needle.

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles, cast on 3 sts for right half of collar.

Next row (right side) K2, P1.

Next row K1, P2.

Next row Cast on 3, work 2nd row of Panel A.

Next row Work 3rd row of Panel A.

Next row Cast on 3, P3, (part of 2nd row of Panel C), work 4th row of Panel A.

Next row Work 1st row of Panel A, K3, inc in last st.

Work as given for left half of collar to**, but working Panel A instead of Panel D and ending with a 2nd row of Panel C before collar shaping.

Next row Patt 54, cast on 8, then patt across sts of left half of collar. 116 sts. Cont in patt across all sts, work 16 rows.

Shape point

Cast off 3 sts at beg of every row until 2 sts rem. K2 tog. Fasten off.

Collar Edgings

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and right side facing, pick up and K 59 sts along straight outside edge of left half of collar and 52 sts along shaped edge to point, turn. 111 sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 4 rows, inc one st at beg of every row. Cast off in rib. Work other side to match.

To Make Up

Join shoulder seams. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew collar in place, beg and ending at centre of front bands. Join row ends of collar edging at point.

Make 2 pompons and cord 10 cm long. Attach 1 pompon to each end of cord. Sew to point of collar, letting 1 pompon hang. Sew on buttons.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more.

Next row Rib 3, [P2 tog, yrn, rib 3, K2 tog, yf, rib 3] to end. Rib 5 rows.

Shape instep

Next row K20 M, 13A, turn.

Next row K13A, turn.

K 22 rows in A on these 13 sts. Break off yarn. Leave these sts on a holder.

With right side facing and M, pick up and K 12 sts evenly along side edge of instep, K13 sts from holder, then pick up and K12 sts evenly along other side edge of instep, K rem sts. 77 sts. Cont in M only, K 17 rows. Beg with a K row, work 9 rows in st st.

Next row [P next st tog with corresponding st 9 rows below] to end.

K 13 rows. Cast off.

Join back seam, reversing seam on cuff to allow for turning. Join under seam folding knitting carefully to lie flat to form mitred corners. With M, make cord approximately 40 cm/15¾ in long and thread through holes.**

Ears

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 3 sts for outer ear. Work in garter st (every row K), inc one st at each end of 3rd and foll alt row. 7 sts. Cont straight until work measures 5 cm/2 in from beg. Cast off. Make one more in A and 2 more for inner ear in B. Join paired pieces together. Fold cast off edges in half and sew through all thicknesses to each side of boot.

Tail

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and A, cast on 5 sts, work in st st for 4 cm/1½ in. Cast off. Fold lengthwise and join seam. Sew to back of bootee.

Make another boot, reversing colours on main part and cord.

Work patt from chart 1, reading K rows from right to left and P rows from left to right, as follows:

Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back.

Next row (right side) With M, moss st 4,

K1M, [1A, 1M] to end.

Next row P1 A, [1M, 1A] to last 4 sts, with M, moss st 4.

Cont in M only.

Next row Moss st 4, K to end.

Next row P to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

Complete as Left Front, reversing all shaping and working patt from chart 1 as follows:

1st row With M, moss st 4, K11 (12:13), K across 1st row of chart 1, with M, K to end.

2nd row With M, P13 (14:15), P across 2nd row of chart 1, with M, P to last 4 sts, moss st 4.

Sleeves

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and M, cast on 33 (35:37) sts. Work 4 rows in moss st as given for Back.

Next row K1C, [1M, 1C] to end.

Next row With M, P twice in first st, [P1C, 1M] to last 2 sts, P1C, with M, P twice in last st.

With M, work 2 rows in st st.

Work patt from chart 2 as follows:

1st row With M, K twice in first st, K9 (10:11), K across 1st row of chart 2, with M, K to last st, K twice in last st.

2nd row With M, P11 (12:13), P across 2nd row of chart 2, with M, P to end.

These 2 rows set patt from chart 2. Work a further 3 rows as set, inc one st at each end of 2nd row. 39 (41:43) sts.

Cont in st st and M only, inc one st at each end of 2nd and every foll 3rd (4th:5th) row until there are 57 (61:65) sts.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures 16 (22:25) cm/6¼ (8½:10) in from beg, ending with a P row. Cast off.

Pockets

With 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles and M, cast on 23 sts.

1st row With M, K1, P1, K1, K across 1st row of chart 3, with M, K1, P1, K1.

1st buttonhole row (right side) Rib 3, cast off 2, rib to last 5 sts, cast off 2, rib to end.

2nd buttonhole row Rib to end, casting on 2 sts over those cast off in previous row. Rib a further 3 rows. Cast off in rib.

Button Band

With 2¾ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, right side facing and M, pick up and K 14 (18) sts evenly along left front edge of opening for girl or right front edge of opening for boy. Beg with a 2nd row, work 8 rows in rib as given for Back welt. Cast off in rib.

Collar

Join shoulder seams.
With 2¾ mm (No 12/US 1) needles, right side facing, M and beg at centre of buttonhole band for girl or button band for boy, pick up and K 23 (24) sts up right front neck, work across back neck sts as follows: [K1, K twice in next st] 13 (15) times, K1, pick up and K 23 (24) sts down left front neck to centre of button band for girl or buttonhole band for boy. 86 (94) sts.
Beg with a 2nd row, work 7 cm/2¾ in in rib as given for Back welt. Cast off loosely in rib.

To Make Up

Lap buttonhole band over button band, then catch down lower ends to cast off sts at base of opening. Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams. Beg at top of welt, join side then sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.
Embroider beak on each duck in B and bow around neck of each duck with C.

Back and Front Alike

Work on first set of sts only. Work 1 row. Dec one st at end of next and every foll alt row until 33 (36) sts rem then at same edge on 2 (3) foll 3rd rows. 31 (33) sts.

Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures 29 (37) cm/11½ (14½) in from beg, ending with a P row. Cont in M only, K 1 row.

Change to 2¾ mm (No 12/US 1) needles.

1st row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

2nd row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

Rep last 2 rows 3 times more then work 1st row again. Cast off in rib.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts, K2 tog, patt to end. Complete to match first side, reversing shaping.

To Make Up

Join side and inside leg seams. Join elastic to form ring. Fold first 3 cm/1¼ in from cast on edge to inside for waist band. Insert elastic, then slip stitch waist band in place.

Next row [K2 tog] twice, K1. P 1 row.

Next row K2 tog, K1. P 1 row.

K 2 tog and fasten off.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 40 (44:48) sts.

Beg with a K row, work 12 rows in st st dec one st at each end of 3rd and foll 6th row.

Next row [K4, K2 tog, K3 (4:5) sts] to end. 32 (36:40) sts.

Change to 2¾ mm (No 12/US 1) needles and work 3 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Next row [Rib 4, inc in next st, rib 3 (4:5) sts] to end. 36 (40:44) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles. Beg with a K row, cont in st st inc one st at each end of 3rd and every foll 4th (5th:6th) row until there are 50 (54:58) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 12 (13:15) cm/4¾ (5:6) in from beg of rib, ending with a P row.

Shape raglan top

Next row K1, K2 tog tbl, K to last 3 sts, K2 tog, K1.

Next row P.

Rep last 2 rows until 14 (16:16) sts rem, ending with a P row. Cast off.

Right Front Band

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles and M, cast on 8 sts.

Work in st st until band when slightly stretched fits up Right Front to beg of neck shaping. Cast off.

With crochet hook, M and right side facing, work picot edging along long straight edge of band as follows: [1 double crochet into next st, 3 chain, slip st in 3rd chain from hook] to end.

Work other side in same way. Place band on top of last few sts at front edge of Right Front and sew in place.

Collar

Join all raglan seams.

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, M and right side facing, pick up and K 54 (58:58) sts evenly around neck edge, omitting front bands.

Beg with a K row, work 2 rows in st st.

Next row K1, inc in next st, K to last 2 sts, inc in next st, K1.

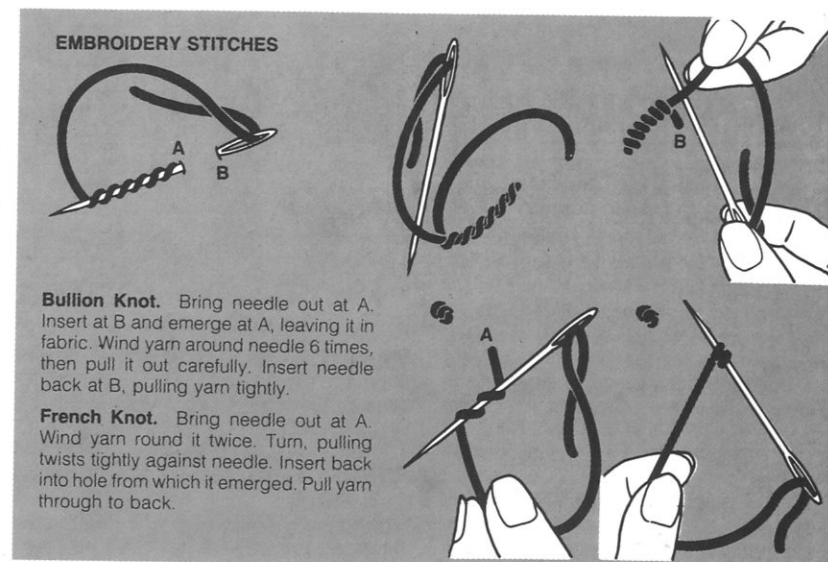
Next row P.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more. Work 2 rows straight. Cast off.

Work picot edging around collar as given for Right Front Band.

To Make Up

Work picot edging along cast on edge of Sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams, reversing seams on cuffs. Turn back cuffs. Make 5 buttonholes by pushing thick needle through 2 thicknesses of Right Front Band, first one 1 cm/¼ in up from cast on edge and last one 1 cm/¼ in down from cast off edge and rem 3 evenly spaced between. Neaten buttonholes. With Yellow and Black, embroider bees along Right Front Band, on each corner of Collar and on top of cuffs, with Bullion Knot and wings with lazy daisy st (see diagram). Embroider heads.



Bullion Knot. Bring needle out at A. Insert at B and emerge at A, leaving it in fabric. Wind yarn around needle 6 times, then pull it out carefully. Insert needle back at B, pulling yarn tightly.

French Knot. Bring needle out at A. Wind yarn round it twice. Turn, pulling twists tightly against needle. Insert back into hole from which it emerged. Pull yarn through to back.

Bootees

Using main colour throughout, work as Bootees of Striped Sweater with Zigzag Collar, omitting edging. Work picot edging around front edge of bootees as given for Right Front Band of Cardigan. Embroider bees on top of each bootee as given for Cardigan.

Beanie Hat

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, cast on 115 sts.

1st row P1, [K1, P1] to end.

2nd row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

Rep these 2 rows until work measures 14 cm/5½ in from beg.

Shape top

Dec row Rib 2, [work 3 tog, rib 3] 18 times, work 3 tog, rib 2. Work 3 rows straight.

Dec row Rib 1, [work 3 tog, rib 1] 19 times. Dec row Rib 1, [work 2 tog] to end. 20 sts. Break off yarn, thread end through rem sts, pull up and secure, then join seam, reversing seam at lower edge to allow for turning.

Feelers (make 2)

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, cast on 7 sts. Work 6 cm/2¼ in in st st. Cast off. Roll lengthwise and slip stitch outside edge. Sew to top of hat.

Beg with a 2nd row, work 2 rows in rib as given for Back.

2nd row P4 (7), *[P1, K1] 3 times, P3, K2, work 2nd row of Panel A, K2, P3, [K1, P1] 3 times*, work 2nd row of Panel B, rep from * to * once, P4 (7).

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels until work measures 40 (47) cm/15¾ (18½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape shoulders

Cast off 13 (14) sts at beg of next 2 rows and 14 (15) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Leave rem 25 (27) sts on a holder.

Front

Work as given for Back until work measures 36 (42) cm/14¼ (16½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape neck

Next row Patt 34 (36), turn. Work on this set of sts only. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at neck edge on every row until 27 (29) sts rem. Cont without shaping for a few rows until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 13 (14) sts at beg of next row. Patt 1 row. Cast off rem 14 (15) sts.

With right side facing, slip first 11 (13) sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to end. Complete to match first side.

Sleeves

With 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles, cast on 35 sts. Work in rib patt as given for Back for 4 (5) cm/1½ (2) in.

Next row Rib 2, [work twice in each of next 2 sts, rib 1] 11 times. 57 sts.

Change to 4 mm (No 8/US 5) needles.

Work in patt as follows:

1st row (right side) *K2, P2, work 1st row of Panel A, P2, K2*, P1, [K1, P1] 3 times, work 1st row of Panel B, P1, [K1, P1] 3 times, rep from * to * once.
2nd row *P2, K2, work 2nd row of Panel A, K2, P2*, P1, [K1, P1] 3 times, work 2nd row of Panel B, P1, [K1, P1] 3 times, rep from * to * once.

These 2 rows set patt. Cont in patt as set, working appropriate rows of Panels, at the same time, inc one st at each end of every foll 3rd row until there are 79 (85) sts, working inc st into moss st patt (as panels at each side of Panel B).

Cont without shaping until work measures 20 (24) cm/8 (9½) in from beg, ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

Collar

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing, slip first 6 (7) sts from holder at centre front neck onto safety pin, rejoin yarn and using set of four 3¼ mm (No 10/US 3) needles K rem 5 (6) sts, pick up and K 15 (17) sts up right front neck, K across 25 (27) sts at back neck inc one st at centre, pick up and K 15 (17) sts down left front neck then K 2 tog, K 4 (5) sts from safety pin. 66 (74) sts. Work 6 rounds in K1, P1 rib, dec one st at

end of last round, turn. 65 (73) sts. Now work backwards and forwards as follows:

Next row K1, [P1, K1] to end.

This row forms moss st.

Next row K1, M1, moss st to last st, M1, K1.

Next row K1, moss st to last st, K1.

Rep last 2 rows until work measures 6 cm/ 2¼ in from beg of moss st. Cast off loosely in moss st.

To Make Up

Sew on sleeves, placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Crochet Hat

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MATERIALS

1 (2) 50g balls of Hayfield Silky Cotton DK. 4.00 mm (US) crochet hook. needles.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit age 18–24 (24–36) months

TENSION

18 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm/4 in over patt.

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = chain; dc = double crochet; ss = slip stitch; tr = treble. Also see page 39.

To Make

With crochet hook, make 3 ch, ss into 1st ch to form a ring, ss in first dc.

1st round Work 6 dc into ring, ss in first dc.

2nd round [2 dc into first st, 1 dc into next st] 3 times, ss into first dc.

3rd round [2 dc into first st, 1 dc into next st] 4 times, 2 dc into next st, ss into first dc.

4th round [2 dc into first st, 2 dc into next st, 1 dc into next st] 4 times, 2 dc into each of next 2 sts, ss into first dc, 24 sts.

5th round 3 ch, 1 tr into last dc of last round, [miss next st, 1 tr into next st, 1 tr into missed st] to end, ss into top of 3 ch.

6th round 1 ch (counts as 1 dc), 1 dc into first st, [2 dc into next st] to end, ss into top of 1 ch. 48 sts.

7th round As 5th round.

8th round 1 ch, 1 dc into first st, 1 dc into each of next 2 sts, 2 dc into next st, [2 dc into next st] to end, ss into top of 1 ch. 72 sts.

9th round As 5th round.

2nd size only

10th round 1 ch, 1 dc into first st, 1 dc into each of next 4 sts, 2 dc into next st, [2 dc into next st, 1 dc into each of next 4 sts, 2 dc into next st] to end, ss into top of 1 ch. 96 sts.

11th round As 5th round.

Both sizes

Next 2 rounds 1 ch, 1 dc into each st to end, ss into top of 1 ch.

Next round As 5th round.

Next round 1 ch, 1 dc into each st to end, ss into top of 1 ch.

Rep last 2 rounds 2 (3) times more.

Next round 1 ch, 1 dc into each st to end, ss into top of 1 ch.

Next round 1 dc into first st, [3 ch, ss into 3rd ch from hook (picot made), miss 1 st, 1 dc into next st] to last st, 3 ch, ss into 3rd ch from hook, ss into top of first dec. Fasten off.

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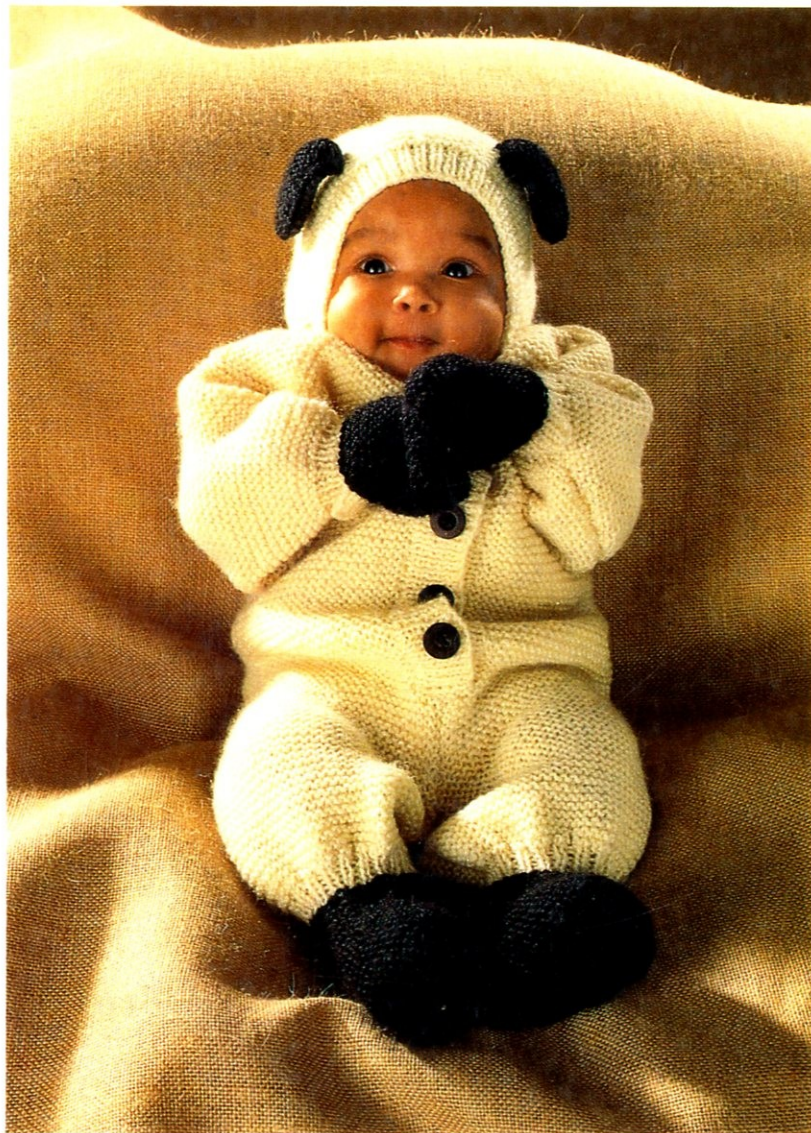
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
